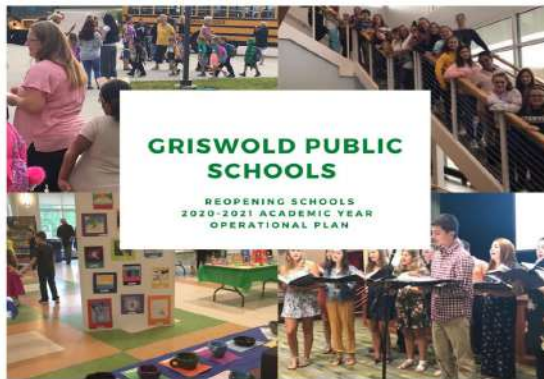

THE REOPENING PLAN

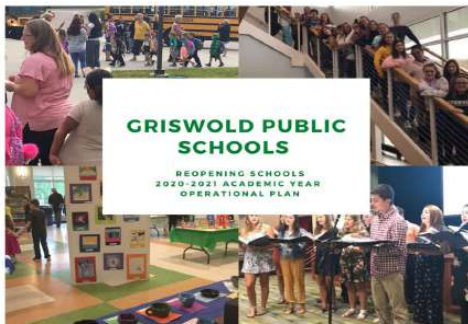

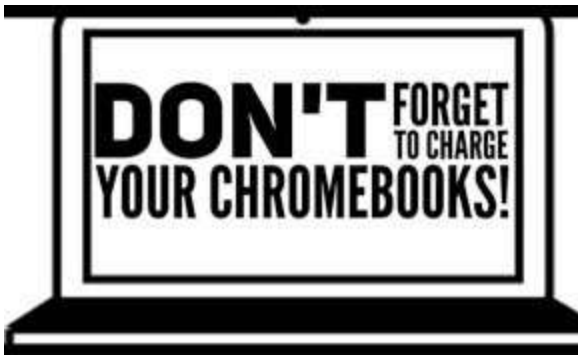
