We are professional school counselors who hold a Master's degree and are licensed by the state of Colorado. School counselors help students in three areas: academics, social/emotional, and future career planning. Our hope is that our comprehensive school counseling program helps every student reach their potential. We will be working with all students this semester in their classrooms in planning for their future. We work with our assistant principals and progress monitor to help students struggling academically. As professional counselors we are there for students emotionally as well. Students are welcome to come in and see us during passing periods and before or after school. Many students email us as well to ask questions or set up times to meet.
