We are off to an excellent start, and I have to thank our staff for their efforts in making it such a It is hard to believe we are now in the month of October. The end of our first quarter is fast approaching! The first nine weeks ends Friday, 10/13. End of quarter marks will be available to view, via ParentVue, on Oct 20. Reminder, GMMS does NOT send report cards home. If you would like a copy of your student's first quarter marks, please call the office and one will be sent home with your student.

I would like to take a moment to remind our families that GMMS is using a new learning management system (LMS) as we continue to grow in the D51 Learning Model. Schoology is our integrated learning management system that provides course/class management, mobile learning, and support for system-wide communication. Schoology enables our students, parents and teachers to engage with learning materials and their school community from the classroom and beyond. We look forward to using Schoology in our classrooms to enhance transparency, connectivity and communication. With an LMS, students can digitally submit homework assignments, review grades, demonstrate learning and growth, receive announcements and feedback, participate in interactive discussions and more. As a parent/guardian, you will be able to view your child's activity in the LMS.

Schoology should not be confused with our Student Information System (SIS). Our SIS or Synergy will continue to be the source for tracking attendance, building schedules, and documenting end of quarter marks, but teachers will be using Schoology for posting daily and weekly grades. You should have already received an email from Schoology for access to your student's Schoology account. If you have not received an email, please call our office. GMMS will be holding a parent Schoology training and support night on Monday, Oct 2, from 3-6, in the computer classroom. This is an open house or drop in training, so stop by, and learn about Schoology. Fall Fundraiser

Counseling Office—Putting Mental Health as a Priority

The mental health team is looking forward to working with students in the classroom during the month of October. We will be facilitating lessons on suicide prevention, drug prevention, and career exploration.

This year we are collaborating with the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) to present lessons in all grade levels. The NAMI Ending the Silence presentation covers: signs/symptoms of mental illness, personal perspectives on the experience of living with mental illness, recovery/coping strategies and ways to seek help. Students will receive resources they can use if mental illness enters their lives. For more information, please visit http://www.namiws.org/

We will also be collaborating with the staff at Pathways, the D51 substance abuse intervention program. We will provide lessons to 7th and 8th grade students on healthy brain development and the effects of drug use on the development of the adolescent brain.

Counseling Office—Academic and Career Plans

We will be meeting with all 8th grade students to focus on developing individual career and academic plans. In the past, we used College in Colorado for career and college exploration but this year we are excited to introduce our 8th grade students to Naviance. Naviance is a college and career readiness software provider that partners with schools to provide students with college planning and career assessment tools.

Box Tops for Education


#1 -Clip Box Tops for Education Coupons
