At Home Learning Options

For situations in which a student may not feel comfortable coming to in-person learning, Wiggins School District has created options for online learning through the district.

Options provided by Wiggins School District RE-50J include:

1. Live Virtual learning provided by each classroom teacher

- a. Students will navigate each day like they are at school. Students who do at home learning through Wiggins School District will join their peers who are at school through Google Meet. Students will follow the same class schedule just as they would if they were at school.
- b. Live Virtual Learning is recommended for students in grades 7-12.
- c. Student who choose to do Live Virtual Learning from home will have 2 weeks from the time they start virtual learning to decide if they wish to continue learning from home, or if they would like to return to in-person learning.

2. Traditional Online learning provided by Colorado Digital Learning Solutions (CDLS).

- a. Students will engage in self-paced online learning while being supported by CDLS teachers and Wiggins support staff
- b. CDLS is recommended for all students K-12th grade.
- Students who choose to do CDLS courses MUST stay enrolled in all courses for a full semester.

Re-admittance After Leaving School District

Parents/guardians who live in Wiggins School District and choose to enroll their students in another school district (including on-line schools), or who choose to home school their students, may not enroll in Wiggins School District during the same school year after the official pupil enrollment count date (currently, October 1st). Parents/guardians may seek admission to the Wiggins School District for the following school year.

Services will not be provided by Wiggins School District to any child who enrolls in another school system including online or homeschool learning.
