

FORT MORGAN OPTIMIST SCHOLARSHIP

All Morgan County high school seniors who are in the top one-third of their class are eligible to apply for the Optimist scholarships and are planning to attend a four year, Junior, Community College or Trade School. This application form qualifies you for all Optimist local scholarships; however, an applicant may be awarded only ONE of these scholarships. The scholarships range in value from \$500-\$1000. This application must be returned to the Fort Morgan Optimist on or before **March 31, 2020**. These scholarships are awarded on the basis of scholarship, leadership, participation and financial need. If you are awarded a Ted Clark, Boettcher, or other large scholarship, you cannot be awarded a Fort Morgan Optimist scholarship. Use of an old application- Not a 2020- will be automatically disqualified. All the information you provide will be destroyed after the scholarships are awarded.

Fort Morgan Optimist Scholarship

The Fort Morgan Optimist Scholarship is a grant given to a graduating senior from any Morgan County high school. The grand is not limited to any particular field. The grant is for a single year.

All monies will be paid to the institution upon receipt of "verification of enrollment" form from the proper school officials. Scholarships awarded after August 1st of scholarship year.

Applicant Requirements:

1. **Must** be a graduating senior in a Morgan County high school or its related equivalent.
2. **Must** rank in the upper 1/2 of his/her class.
3. **Must** demonstrate qualities of leadership and character.
4. **Must submit a comprehensive letter of recommendation from at least one person in authority from school.**
5. You **must** submit two letters of recommendation from a person who is not an educator and not a relative.
6. **Must submit a copy of an official transcript.**
7. **Must** submit a letter explaining family's obligations, resources, financial needs, and personal life goals.
