Homecoming and Spirit Week are going to be very exciting times here at GHS! Please take note of these dates:


- Friday, November 15th: Homecoming Kick Off Week with the Homecoming football game

- Thursday, November 28th: Thanksgiving Football Game at 10 a.m. Homecoming Court to be announced at halftime!




