## PARENTS RIGHT TO KNOW NOTICE

As a parent/legal guardian of a child in attendance at any of the schools in Chinle Unified School District (Mesa View Elementary School, Chinle Elementary School, Canyon de Chelly Elementary School, Chinle Junior High School, Tsaile Elementary School, Many Farms Public School, Chinle High School, Hozho Online Academy), you have the right to request information regarding the teaching qualifications and certification of any teacher or instructional assistant who works with your child.

## 34 CFR § 200.61 - Parents' right to know

§ 200.61 Parents' right to know

(a) Information for parents

(1) At the beginning of each school year, an LEA that receives funds under this subpart (Title I) must notify the parents of each student attending a title I school that the parents may request, and the LEA will provide the parents on request and in a timely manner, information regarding the professional qualifications of the student's classroom teachers, including, at a minimum, the following:

(i) Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.

(ii) Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.

(iii) Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.

(iv) Whether the parent's child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

(2) A school that participates under this subpart must provide to each parent -

(i) Information on the level of achievement and academic growth, if applicable and available, of the parent's child on each of the State academic assessments required under section 1111(b)(2) of the ESEA; and

(ii) Timely notice that the parent's child has been assigned, or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by, a teacher who does not meet applicable State certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned.
