Application Procedure

- 1. The application should contain:
 - a. Application form
 - b. Personal <u>handwritten</u> <u>or typed</u>, letter outlining goals and objective for the future.
 - c. One letter of recommendation written by an adult familiar with your career goals.
 - d. Official transcript of high school courses and grades.
- 2. Applicants selected as finalists will be invited for a personal interview in before May 10, 2021. At this time the applicant will be asked questions regarding strengths/weaknesses, past honors and future expectations.
- 3. Deliver completed Scholarship Applications to: the Fort Morgan High School Counseling Office or to: Lincoln High School Counselor at Lincoln High School. on or before **April 29, 2022.**
