PASS is an amazing after-school academy. The Spring session runs **March 28th - June 8th, every** Monday – Thursday from 2:45pm – 5:30pm. The program is funded by a grant from the State of Connecticut.

PASS will be CLOSED on: April 14th, April 18th - 22nd (Happy Vacation!), May 18th, May 19th, May 25th and May 30th

During each PASS session a variety of activity clubs are offered. As well, there are opportunities for help with homework and academic support from tutors. Your child chooses the clubs that are of most interest to them. We do our best to build club rosters based upon these preferences.

Enrollment in the PASS Spring Session is limited to 100 students. The PASS program is required to meet State Department of Education guidelines for student attendance throughout the year. Students are expected to attend at least 85% of the meeting dates. For the past eight years, the PASS program achieved very high ratings for attendance that has provided strong evidence for renewing the after school grant. Students not meeting the attendance requirements may be disqualified from enrollment in PASS sessions.

There are approximately 36 days of PASS per session over a 10 to 11 week time period. The registration fee is \$100 per session. This equates to approximately \$2.75 per day for 2.75 hours of programming and a healthy snack. PASS registration fees are among the lowest of the programs funded by the Connecticut After School Grant.

These clubs run during <u>Session A</u> - Monday and Wednesday. Please be sure to have the appropriate club numbers listed in the <u>Session A</u> on your child's form.
