

Penny War!

Help Student Council "MAKE THAT CHANGE!" with the 2014 **Penny War** from Monday, February 3rd-Friday, February 7th. In a Penny War, grade levels compete against each other with coins. Pennies are positive points, silver and paper dollars are negative points. During lunch, students with money in hand will use the jars on the stage to put pennies in their grade level jars, and silver and dollars in other grade level jars to "bomb" them. Our school goal is to raise \$500 to benefit "Make That Change," a foundation that provides assistance Arizona's Special Olympians. The grade level with the most pennies (or fewest negative points) wins a donut party!

Knox Student Council "Penny War" Rules



All grade levels will be involved in "Penny Wars." Here is how it works....

1. Grade-level jars will be marked and situated on the cafeteria stage during lunch. Student Council officers or reps will be present during all lunches that week to help monitor.
2. Only students with money in their hands will be allowed near the jars and students with money will go ONCE each lunch period to the jars to deposit it as they wish. Students can bring in money every day if they wish.
3. Pennies are POSITIVE points (put those in YOUR grade level jar).
4. Silver and paper are NEGATIVE points (bomb OTHER grade level jars with those)!
5. Points are one-for-one. Pennies= +1, nickels= -5, dimes= -10, quarters= -25, dollars= -100, etc.
6. Money put into the wrong jar will not be moved.
7. Do not put trash, paper, or fake money into the jars. It's very hard to get out.
8. Penny War starts Monday, February 3rd during the first lunch and ends Friday, February 7th after the movie night.
9. Grade level with the best count (usually the LEAST NEGATIVE) will be awarded a donut party!
10. Money jars will be counted by student council, then by a local bank.
11. All money goes to Make That Change, benefitting Arizona's Special Olympics Athletes!
