The 2015 Florida Performance Tour for College Park Orchestras

Touring is the highlight of the high school student's musical experience. The tour experience extends musicians' abilities, bonds student musicians into a more cohesive ensemble, and gives students the opportunity to showcase both their talents and the musical excellence of the College Park Instrumental Music program. College Park High School award-winning ensembles have a rich history of concert tours. Tours in recent years include the: Disney recording studio experience; International Music Festival in New York and Carnegie Hall performance; Chicago Symphony and North Western University tour; Washington DC and Kennedy Center for Performing Arts; and Pacific Basin Music Festival in Hawaii. Touring has allowed our ensembles to compete in international music festivals, participate in professional studio recording sessions and engage in enriching musical exchanges with high schools, colleges, universities and with professional musicians across the country. Following in that rich tradition of tour experiences, we are planning a Florida Performance Tour April 8-14, 2015.

The Florida Performance tour will feature performances and clinics at Universal Orlando and Walt Disney World, a joint concert with a local high school, clinics at a Florida University and an educational experience at Kennedy Space Center. A detailed proposed itinerary from our travel agent, World Projects, is attached.

Our String Orchestra and our Symphony Orchestra will be performing on the tour. The Symphony Orchestra is comprised of select string, wind and percussion students in the College Park Instrumental Music Program. The following students will be attending:

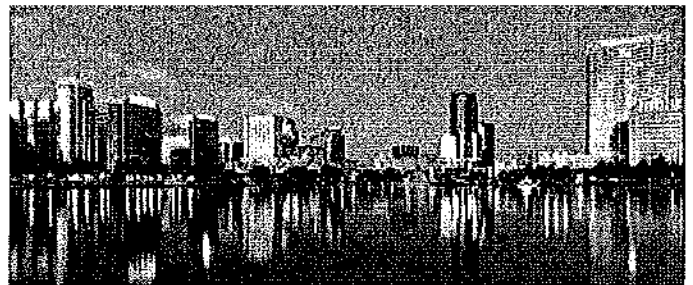

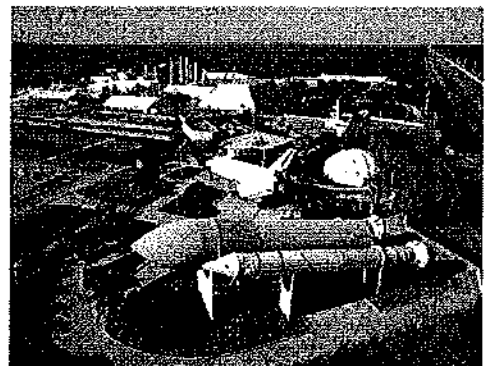
DAY ONE: Wednesday, April 8, 2015 – PLEASANT HILL → ORLANDO, FLORIDA (D)

- 7:00am Arrive at San Francisco International Airport at least 2.5 hours prior to flight departure.
Meet your World Projects Tour Manager who will assist with check in for your flights to Orlando.
Move through security to your departure gate. You may wish to purchase food to bring on the flight.
- 9:52am Depart SFO for Orlando on United Flight #234.
- 6:18pm Arrive into Orlando!
Load the coach(es) and transfer to dinner location TBD.
- Evening Enjoy dinner as a group (pizza party or buffet-style restaurant).
After dinner, transfer to your hotel (*possibly the Hampton Inn Lake Buena Vista*) and check-in.



DAY TWO: Thursday, April 9, 2015 – KENNEDY SPACE CENTER (B, D with hosts) – Exchange Performance

- Morning Breakfast at the hotel.
This morning, load the coach(es) with instruments and performance attire and transfer to the Kennedy Space Center.
Enjoy time to explore the Kennedy Space Center – your ticket includes a Kennedy Space Center tour, IMAX films, the Space Shuttle Atlantis, the interactive space-flight simulators, a chance to meet an astronaut, and all exhibits.
- Afternoon Lunch on own at the Kennedy Space Center.
Afterwards, transfer to local school (possibly Titusville H.S., Astronaut H.S., or West Shore Sr. H.S.).
Greet hosts and enjoy a short soundcheck on stage at the host venue.
- Evening Potluck dinner with hosts.
Exchange PERFORMANCE with local space coast area school.
After the concert, return to the hotel in Orlando.





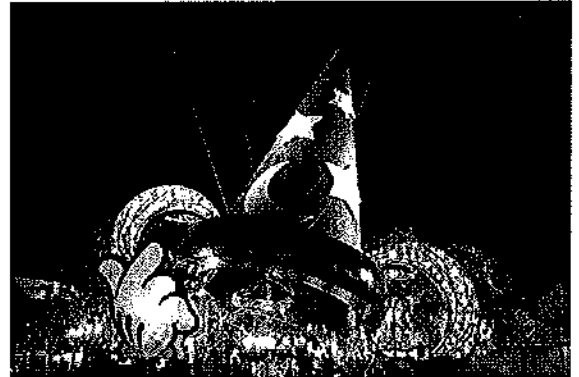

Hollywood Studios is where Disney movie magic comes to life. With attractions based on blockbuster movies, you'll begin to see yourself as part of the action!

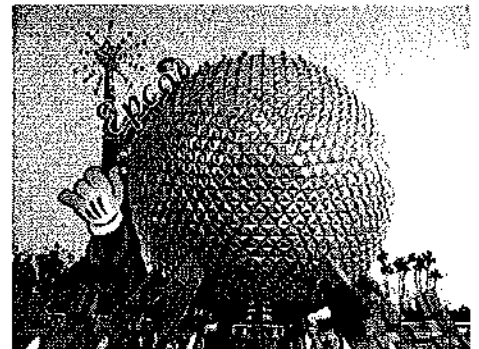

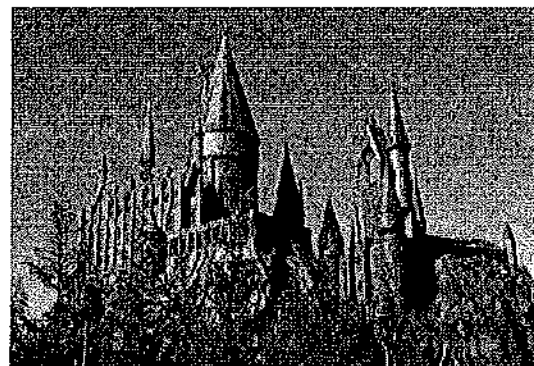

- ♪ **Payments:** All payments must be made by check, bank check or cash – credit cards will not be accepted.
- ♪ **Gratis:** Three (3) to five (5) gratis packages are based on Double Occupancy Price. One (1) additional gratis package is based on Single Occupancy Price.
- ♪ **Costs:** Costs are based on 2015 prices. This quote is subject to availability of accommodation and vehicles at the time of booking.
- ♪ **Airfare:** Airfare is based on an actual air quote from United Airlines – currently 94 seats are being held on United for the departing flight – should air deposit not be received by the below due date, World Projects will have to release seats being held and re-request once CPHS has deposited on the air – additional costs may apply should WP have to re-request seats. Please note, base airfare is guaranteed, however taxes and surcharges are subject to change until ticketing is complete.
- ♪ **Baggage:** Baggage fees are set by the individual airlines. Currently, baggage fees for United is \$25 for the 1st bag each way and \$35 for the second bag each way, subject to change at any time. World Projects has included the current first bag fee of \$25 each way (\$50 roundtrip) for each traveler and \$1500 towards second checked bag fees and/or overweight-oversized fees that may be incurred by checked instruments. CPHS will be responsible for any and all additional fees that exceed \$1500. Fees are to be paid at the airport when the group checks in.
- ♪ **Quad / Triple Rooms:** Quad occupancy is four (4) people per room / two (2) beds per room and triple occupancy is three (3) people per room / two (2) beds per room – sharing beds will be necessary.
- ♪ **Disney Performing Arts and Universal Stars Program:** Application and acceptance are required for both programs. World Projects will assist the director in the audition process. Performances are scheduled on a first come/first served basis, subject to availability.
- ♪ **Numbers:** World Projects reserves the right to recast the tour should the number of travelers be different from those detailed above.
- ♪ **Agreement:** Once the tour has been deposited on, World Projects will issue a Performance Agreement detailing the costs, inclusion/exclusions, payment and cancellation schedule, and terms of the tour proposal for the director to sign.
