#### Student Advocate and Support


#### • Crisis Intervention





# Advisory

- Small, diverse groups of students that mirror the makeup of the school
- Focus on the development of the middle school adolescent with an emphasis on social-emotional skill building (Second Step Curriculum)
- Addresses unwritten curriculum: how to "do" school
  - i.e. study skills, communication, etc...
- Advisory teacher often serves as a mentor in the student's school life

# Reading and Writing


- Explore a wide variety of fiction and nonfiction texts





#### **NWEA...**

• Students demonstrate their growth in the areas of reading and math three times per year (Fall, Winter, Spring).

Students conference with teachers regarding their progress.

Students and parents have access to NWEA results in Skyward.

 Scores are used to determine if students should receive extra support through targeted intervention courses.



# Performing Arts

# Band Full Year Course

# **Band Instrument Options**

 Percussion is available with special try-out held during elementary instrument try-ons.

# These instruments require additional private lessons or summer band camp:

 Oboe, Bassoon, Alto Sax, Tenor Sax, and French Horn.

- Summer Camp Offered


# **Choir Full Year Course**
