



Elementary Art Show Prospectus

WHAT: The Festival of the Arts is a celebration of student achievement in the Visual and Performing Arts. It is a venue for our community to experience the talent and efforts of the CNUSD art students.

WHERE: At our exciting venue, *The Corona Heritage Park*, celebrates the history of Corona and simultaneously acts as a hub for current community events and organizations celebrating the arts and unique facets of our shared past.

Art Work turned into School Rep	Friday, March 10
Art Work turned into Fran Rife (Location to be determined)	Tuesday, March 28th
Art Festival	Sat., April 1st 10:00am-2:00pm

ENTRY GUIDELINES:

- Each elementary site is allowed to submit a maximum 10 pieces of individual student produced artwork or 1 collaborative/collage piece made by multiple students.

- Maximum of one art piece per student
 - Art work can be on plain paper, construction paper, or watercolor paper.
 - Can be 3 dimensional: clay, legos, paper sculpture, etc.
 - It can be a photograph or computer generated art piece.
 - Please no framed art work, no work on or mounted on foam board
- Art work on plain paper, photographs, construction paper, or watercolor paper must be mounted on black construction paper with ½” border all the way around
- Please use glue sticks, rubber cement or spray adhesive to mount the art work.
 - Double stick tape doesn't last and Elmers glue wrinkles the paper.
 - Each piece of art work must have a label on the front on the bottom right hand corner, taped to the back so it is not attached to the art work itself. Label should include the artist's name, teacher's name, grade level and school. See example below.
- Individual student work may not exceed 8 1/2”x 11” (inches)
- If submitting 1 collaborative/collage art piece, it may not exceed 18x24” in size.
- Subject matter must be acceptable for public viewing.



ONLINE ENTRY FORM:

- Please enter all work online Festival of the Arts page on the CNUSD website by Friday, March 15th, 2023 <http://www.cnusd.k12.ca.us/artsfestival>
- *Only CNUSD staff or teachers can submit art.* Please submit your art to your Art Festival rep or principal at your school site.
- **CNUSD Art Reps/Staff:** On this website go to the button labeled "Submission Form Student Artwork." This will direct you to the CNUSD Ed Services Page labeled "Submission Form Student Artwork."
- Form Student Artwork." This will direct you to the CNUSD Ed Services Page labeled "Submission Form Student Artwork."
- Choose Student Art Work Submission Form
- Type the title of the art piece or type "untitled"
- Student Artist Name (If collaborative piece use teachers name)
- Student ID Number (If collaborative piece, choose one ID to enter)
- Select school level from drop down menu. (elementary)
- Attach a jpeg photo of the art work (this help us identify the art work in case a label is missing)
- List the medium or process of the artwork (watercolor, oil pastels, crayons, etc)
- Select grade and school
- Make sure to save the entry
