

## AUHSD Graduation and College Admission Requirements

---

Students are required to earn 240 credits for graduation. Ten credits are granted for successfully completing a course that meets each day for a school year; five credits are granted for a semester course.

<b>Science</b>	<i>20 Credits</i> One year Physical and One year Life Science	<i>20 Credits (30 Credits recommended)</i> Lab Sciences: Physical and Life
<b>Social Studies</b>	<i>30 Credits</i> World History/Geography US History Government/Economics	<i>20 Credits</i> World History US History (or semester of US History and semester of Government)
<b>Visual/Performing Arts</b>	<i>10 Credits</i> One year of Visual or Performing Arts	<i>10 Credits</i> One yearlong course
<b>World Language</b>	<i>20 Credits</i> Two years in any of the following areas: World Language, American Sign Language, or Career Technical Ed	<i>20 Credits (30 Credits recommended)</i> Two years of the same language
<b>Career Technical Education</b>		None
<b>Physical Education</b>	<i>20 Credits</i> PE 9 and additional 10 credits	None
<b>Health</b>	<i>5 Credits</i> Human and Social Development Course	None
<b>Electives</b>	<i>65 Credits</i>	<i>10 Credits</i> College Prep electives
