# Middle School to High School

- 1) At the end of a trimester students earn...

Middle School → Grades  
High School → Grades and CREDITS

Credits are  
very  
important!

- ❖ **Students must have at least a D- to earn a credit.**  
(If you get an F in Algebra I A, you retake the whole course.)

- ❖ **Credits are necessary for Graduation (at least 40).**

- 1) Middle School → Standards Based Grading  
High School → Traditional Grading

- ❖ **Academic Deadlines are Important and Retesting is limited!**

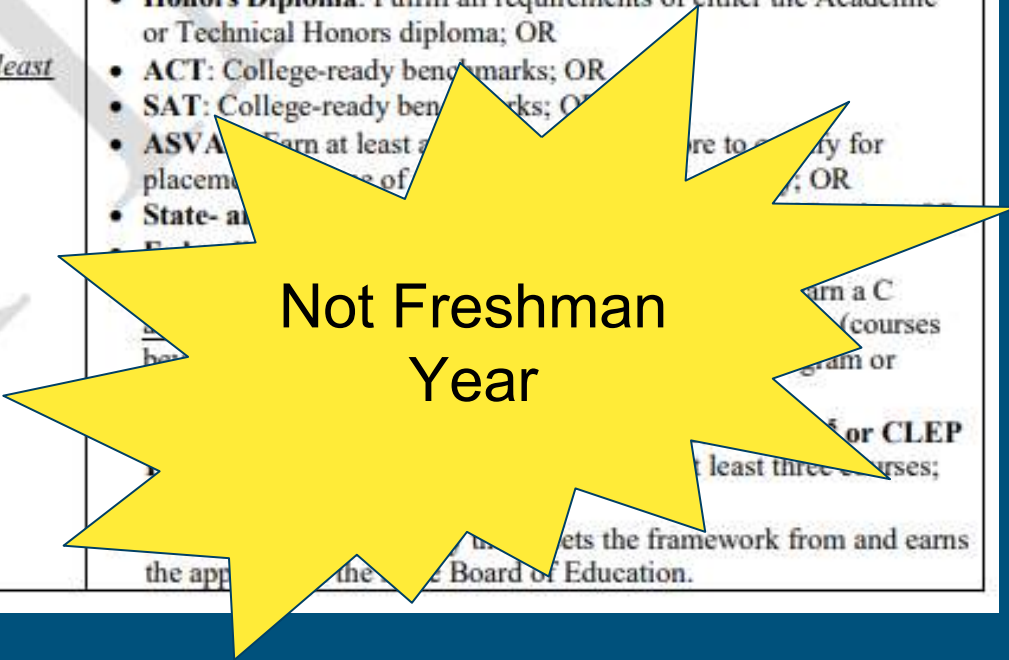

Graduation Requirements	Graduation Pathway Options
1) <b>High School Diploma</b>	Meet the statutorily defined diploma credit and curricular requirements.
2) <b>Learn and Demonstrate Employability Skills<sup>1</sup></b> (Students must complete <u>at least one</u> of the following.)	Learn employability skills standards through locally developed programs. Employability skills are demonstrated by <u>one</u> the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Project-Based Learning Experience;</b> OR</li><li>• <b>Service-Based Learning Experience;</b> OR</li><li>• <b>Work-Based Learning Experience.<sup>2</sup></b></li></ul>
3) <b>Postsecondary-Ready Competencies<sup>3</sup></b> (Students must complete <u>at least one</u> of the following.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Honors Diploma:</b> Fulfill all requirements of either the Academic or Technical Honors diploma; OR</li><li>• <b>ACT:</b> College-ready benchmarks; OR</li><li>• <b>SAT:</b> College-ready benchmarks; OR</li><li>• <b>ASVAB:</b> Earn at least a minimum AFQT score to qualify for placement into one of the branches of the US military; OR</li><li>• <b>State- and Industry-recognized Credential or Certification;</b> OR</li><li>• <b>Federally-recognized Apprenticeship;</b> OR</li><li>• <b>Career-Technical Education Concentrator<sup>4</sup>:</b> Must earn a C <u>average</u> in at least two non-duplicative advanced courses (courses beyond an introductory course) within a particular program or program of study; OR</li><li>• <b>AP/IB/Dual Credit/Cambridge International courses<sup>5</sup> or CLEP Exams:</b> Must earn a C <u>average</u> or higher in at least three courses; OR</li><li>• <b>Locally created pathway</b> that meets the framework from and earns the approval of the State Board of Education.</li></ul>

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## BOX 1: Pick a Diploma and Earn Credits

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We have three main diploma types to choose from:

**Core 40**

**Academic Honors**

**Technical Honors**



# Academic Honors Diploma - Requires 47 Credits

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**Complete ALL Core 40 requirements PLUS EARN:**

- ❖ 2 additional math credits
- ❖ 6 foreign language credits
- ❖ 2 fine arts credits
- ❖ Earn a “C” or higher in all classes counting for the diploma
- ❖ Have a grade point average of a B (3.0) or better

And complete one of the following:

6 college credits from priority course list (2 dual credit classes at WNHS)  
SAT score 1250 or higher (Minimum Reading 590; Minimum Math 560)  
ACT of 26 or higher



# Technical Honors Diploma - Requires 47 Credits

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**Complete ALL Core 40 requirements AND:**

- ❖ Earn a “C” or higher in all classes counting for the diploma
- ❖ Have a grade point average of a B (3.0) or better
- ❖ Earn 6 credits in a vocational program
- ❖ Earn certification or dual credits from vocational program

And complete one of the following:

6 college credits from priority course list (2 dual credit classes at WNHS)  
SAT score 1250 or higher (Minimum Reading 590; Minimum Math 560)  
ACT of 26 or higher
