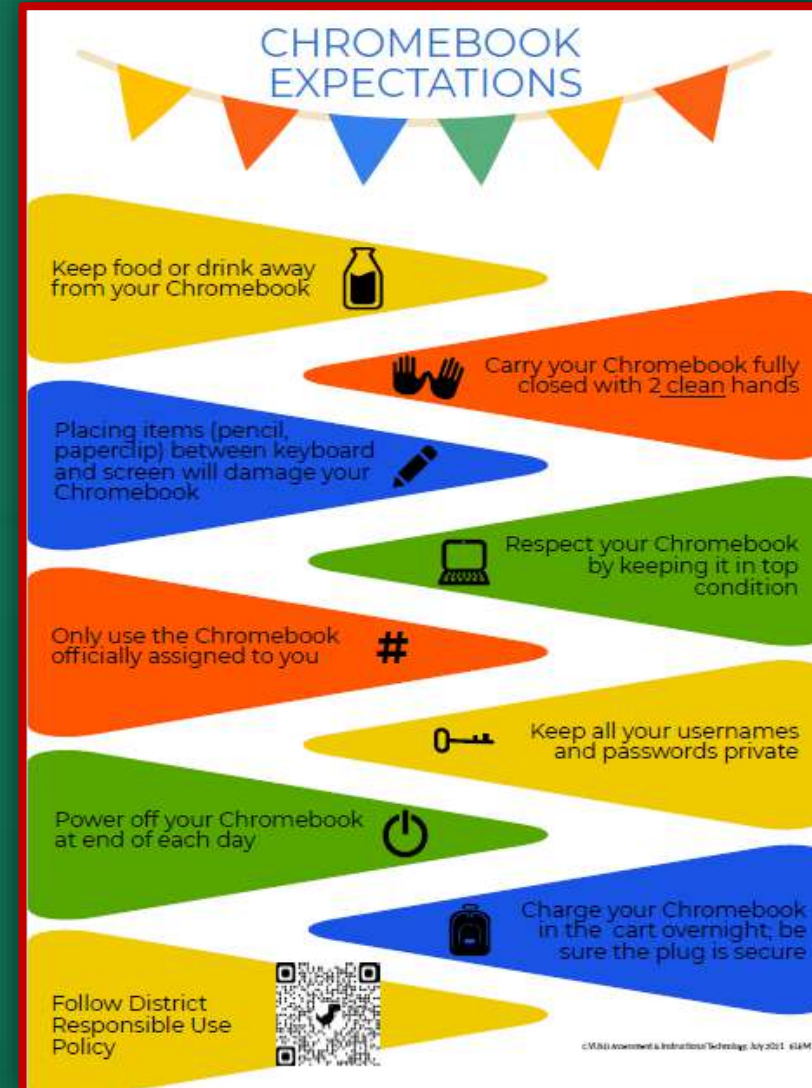
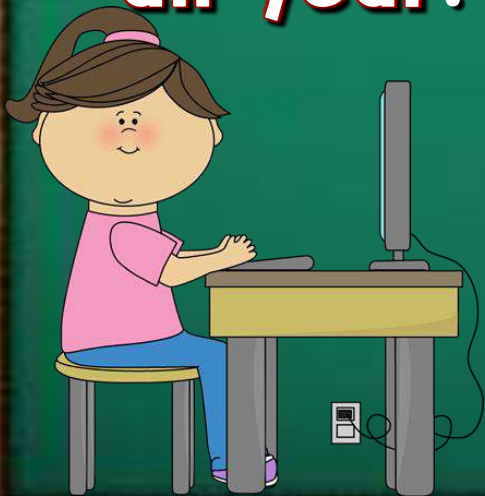
Learning Objective: To ride a bike by yourself
