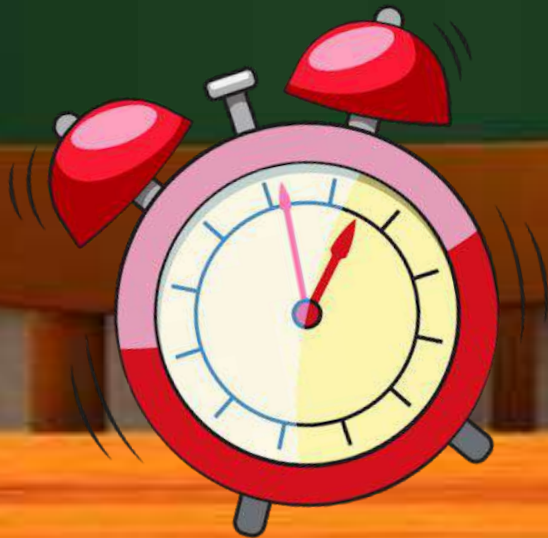

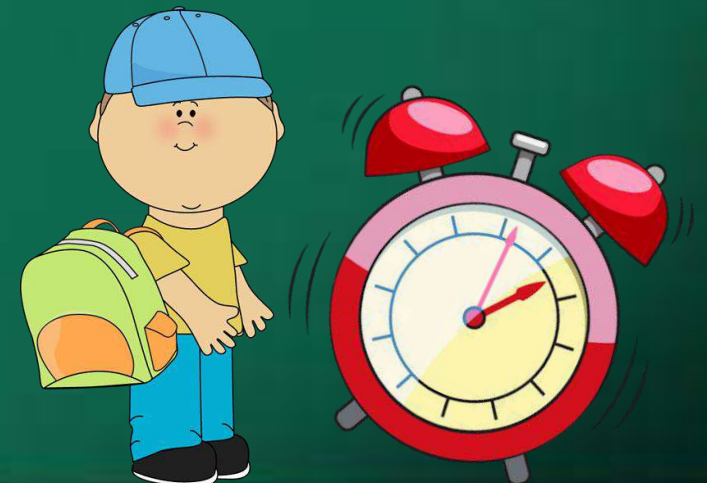

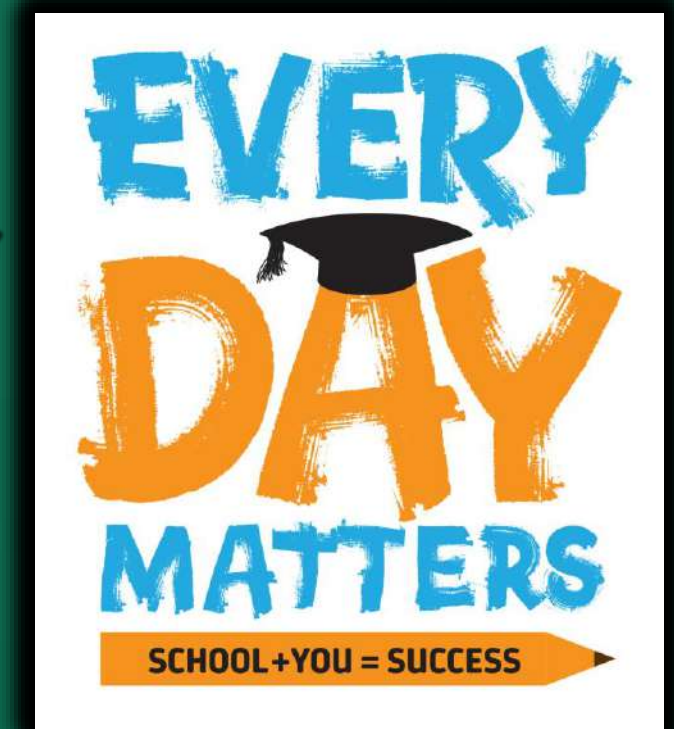

Attendance

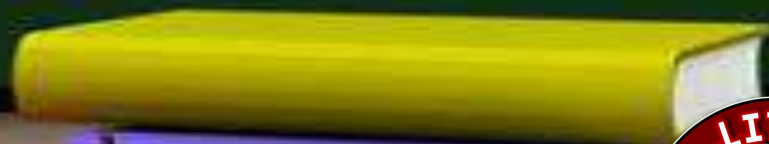

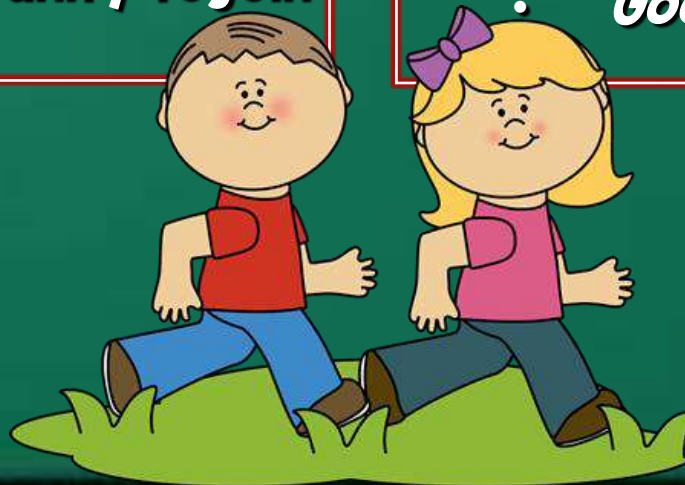

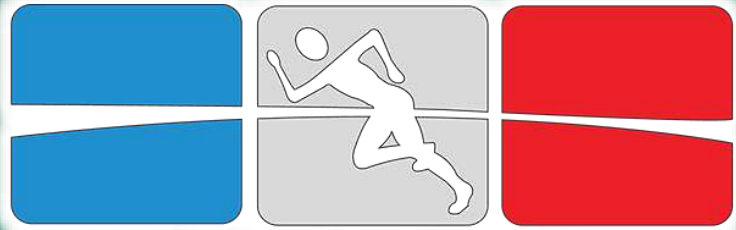

Learning Objective: To ride a bike by yourself

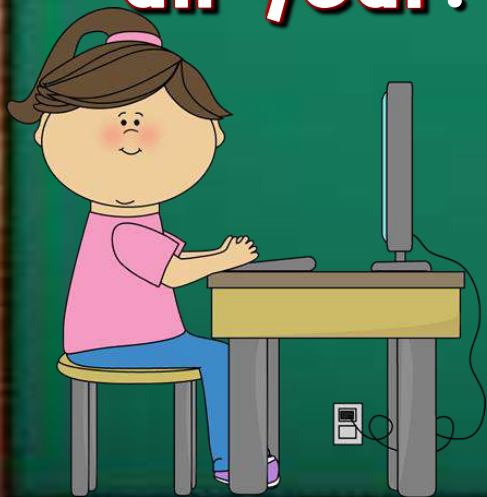
	4	Extending the Standard Wow! You not only ride a bike on your own, but you can pop a wheelie, jump ramps, and perform other bike stunts.
