 - b. CSF dues of **\$5.00**
 - c. **Transcript from your counselor and/or career**
- *Your application WILL NOT be considered unless all three items are included.
NO LATE APPLICATIONS ARE ACCEPTED.**

B. Membership Qualifications:

1. You must earn a minimum of **10 points** from last semester's grades.
 - a. The first 4 or more points must come from List I. (Two courses minimum)
 - b. The first 7 points or more points must come from List I or II (including those from section "a" above).(Three courses minimum)
 - c. The remaining required points to reach 10 points can come from List III.
 2. Grades:
 - a. A grade of **"A" = 3 points**
 - b. A grade of **"B" = 1 point**
 - c. One additional point shall be awarded to AP or Honors classes with an "A" or "B" for up to **two** such classes per semester.
 - d. A grade of "C" = 0 points (DO NOT LIST BELOW)
 - e. A grade of "D" or "F" in any course you took (even those you did not list below) disqualifies you from membership for the semester
- C. You can only use up to **5 courses** to reach your required 10 points.
 D. Semester membership is based on work done in the Previous Semester.
 E. You **MUST** reapply **EACH** semester.
 F. Everyone must complete the following table.
