• The kindergartners are learning the letter "Ee" and the number "5". They have also been learning sign language and learning Halloween songs. In the afternoon, they have been learning about Community Helpers. The first and second grades are working on ten facts, doubles, helper facts and tally marks. Reading and spelling are progressing well. In the afternoons, they are learning about Community Helpers, primary and secondary sources, and being respectful, but assertive.
