A great option for college bound Farmington High School Students

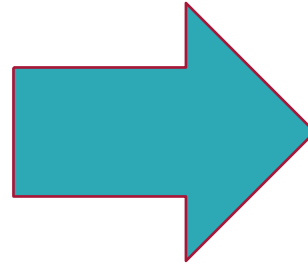
WHAT IS THE COC?



- A certificate from Weber State University stating all General Education requirements are fulfilled
- The COC can be presented to any state university or college and their GE requirements are met or waived, if they are different.
- Approximately 45 college credits from either AP or CE courses. (minimum of 10 hours must be CE through WSU)

BENEFITS OF THE COC

- For Example:
 - A Student Attending Utah State University that has earned the Weber COC
 - Waives a year and a half of college
 - Saves students over \$20,000 in tuition, fees, books and housing costs.
 - Helps prepare students for the rigors of college academics
 - Waives difficult “Freshman Weed-out” classes.
 - Students graduate from college one and a half years earlier, entering the workforce sooner, with thousands in salary gained.

Students that receive The Weber State General Education Certificate of Completion (COC), can present it to any State of Utah college or university and have all General Education classes waived at that school. Students must pass all AP exams with a 3, 4 or 5 and submit their scores to Weber State. (Many requirements need a 4 on the AP exam for completion) All CE courses require a grade of C or better to complete the requirement for the COC and a minimum of 15 hours must come through CE credit with Weber State Univ.

A POTENTIAL PROBLEM....

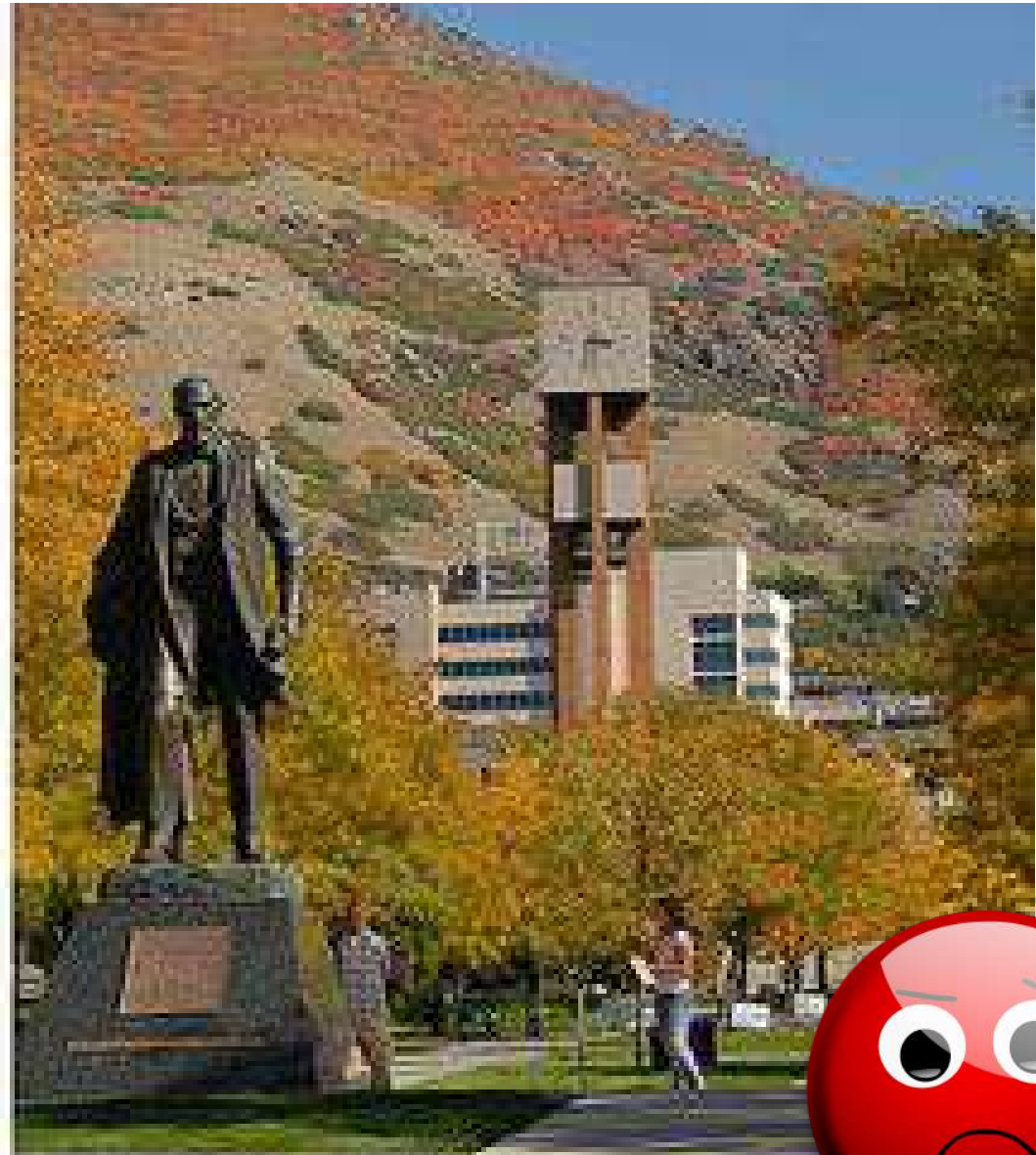
What Major?

 - Log on to Utahfutures.org and establish a list of potential careers and majors.

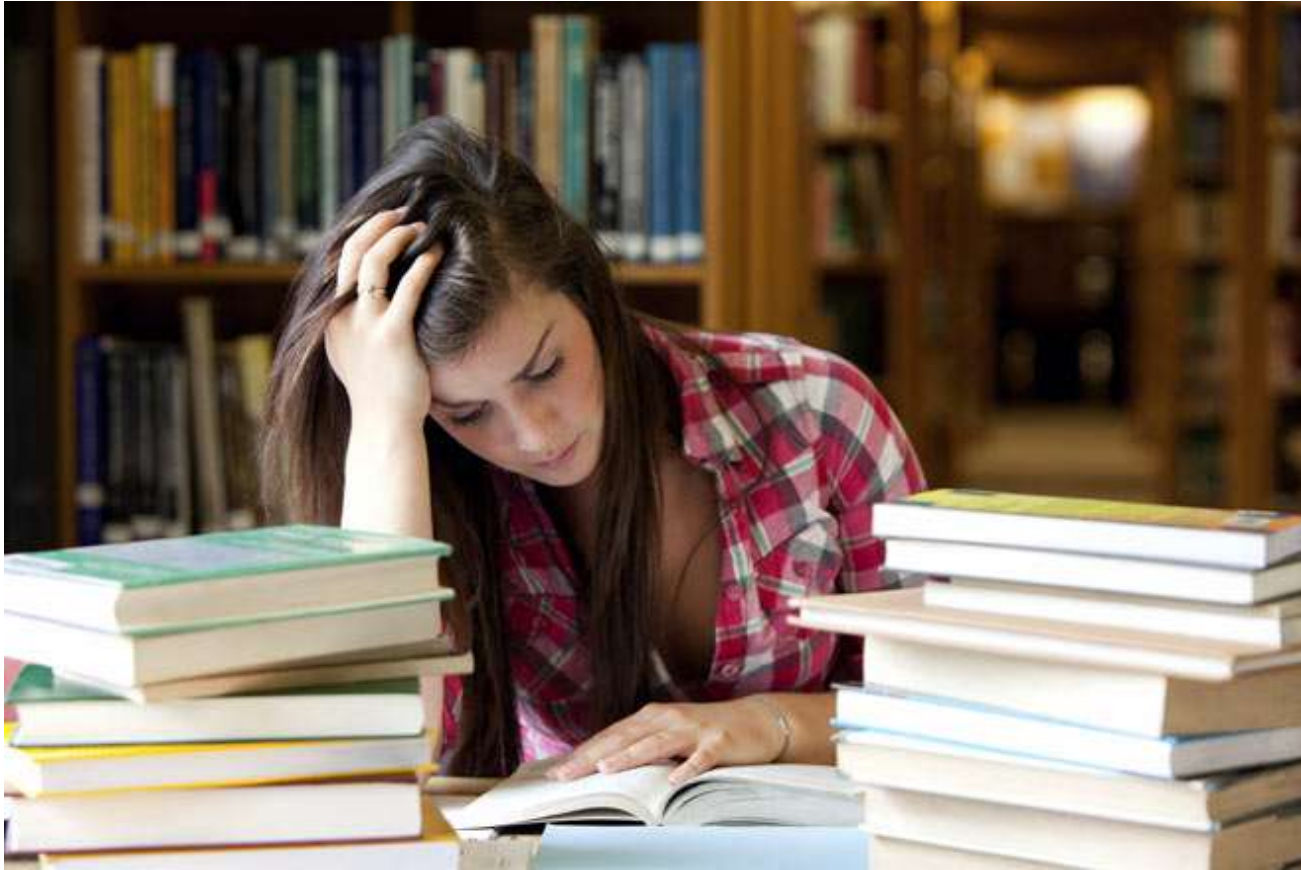


POTENTIAL PITFALLS.....

- High school students taking CE classes are establishing a college GPA.
 - Low grades can negatively affect admissions to selective undergraduate programs or graduate schools such as:
 - Medical School
 - Dental School
 - Law School
 - Nursing
 - Business

Students with STEM majors who have earned their COC may face challenges their first year in college, because some COC classes are often used to lighten a difficult schedule.
