The Advanced Placement course is an opportunity to earn college course credit for those students who demonstrate ability, interest, and motivation to prepare and take an advanced placement exam. Grades earned for AP courses are computed on a scale A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 1, F = 0. To enroll for an AP course, students must plan to register to take the AP exam and/or complete an alternative project. Parents, students, and teachers will be asked to sign a contract that clarifies class expectation.
