Credit Recovery-Electives

- o **Work Study-** Students can earn .50 credits per quarter (2.0 credits per year).
- o **Community Service-** (can be earned over summer). Students can earn .50 credits for every 60 hours of community service, with a maximum of 2.0 credits (240 hours).
- o **Life Skills Seminar Program-** Community High School will offer 10-15 opportunities to attend presentations and educational seminars focused on Life Skills and Healthy Living.
- o **Winning Futures Mentoring Program-** .50 credit

Career Prep Center

- o Many students attend the Career Prep Center during A block for an additional credit each year.
- o Most qualify for 4th Math Credit and additional VPA class
- o Schedule looks like:
 - o Hours 1-2 at CPC, and hours 2-6 Community High

- ◊ Smaller class sizes; most under 23
- ◊ Approximately 175 students
- ◊ Participation in ALNET athletics- basketball, volleyball, quiz bowl, softball, Cedar Pointe
- ◊ High School diploma with commencement ceremony- Must take SAT/M-Step
- ◊ Days coordinate with traditional high schools
- ◊ Senior Award Program- Graduation Walk with Holden

Expectations
