

STUDENT INFORMATION

Students are required to attend an orientation and to submit required documents to CVUSD, which can be arranged with the instructor directly.

Each course requires a minimum of 25 hours per week to complete a semester class.

This year due to the COVID-19 shut down and campus closure the final exams may be remote and will require proctoring. Please note the details will come from your instructor directly and there are no re-takes of the final exam.

All students are encouraged to maintain a notebook with course content notes and notations regarding dates and times of student/instructor interaction.

All courses are high school credit; transferability of credit is determined by each student's school site. Students must receive prior approval from their school before registering for a class.
