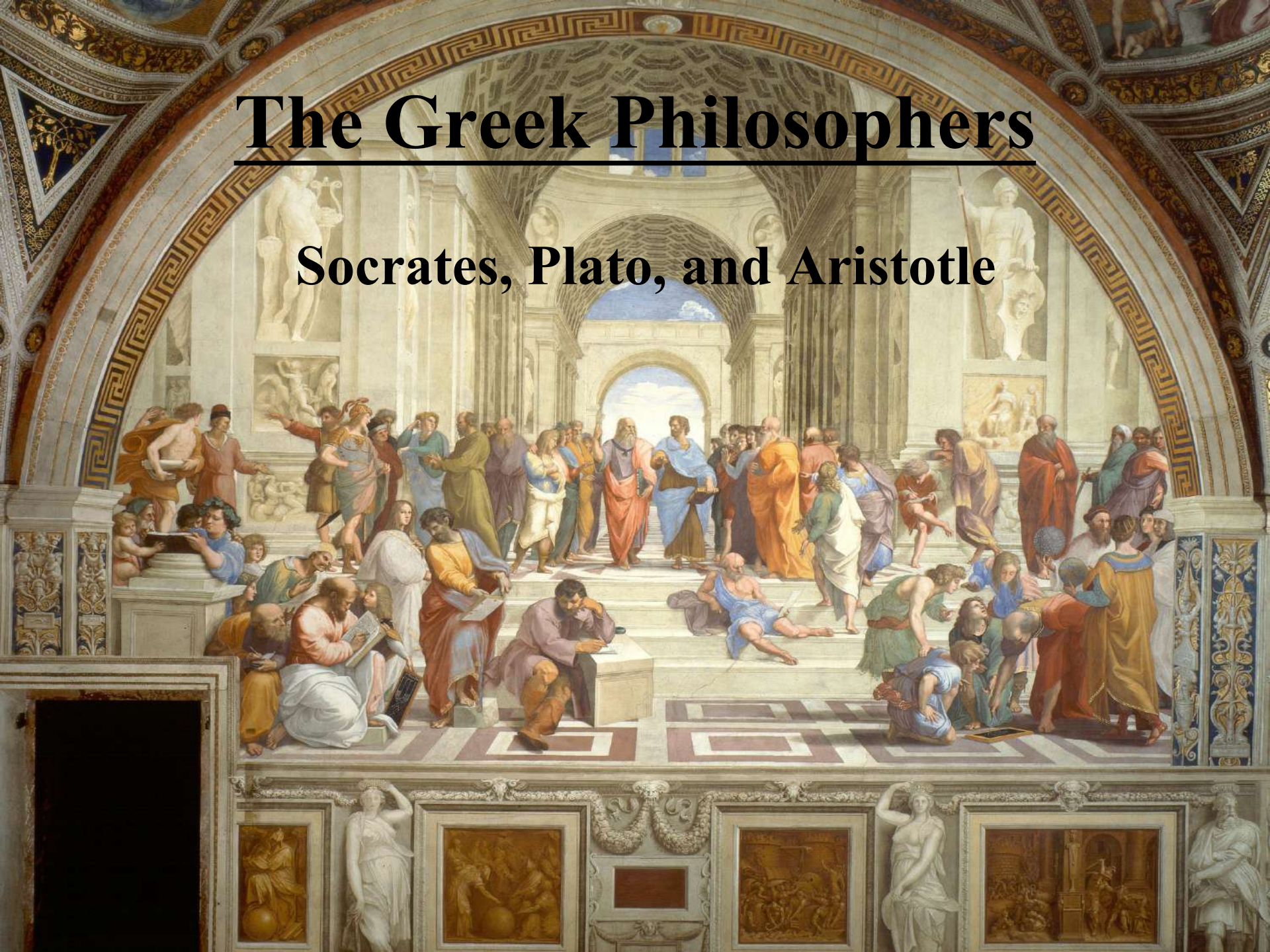
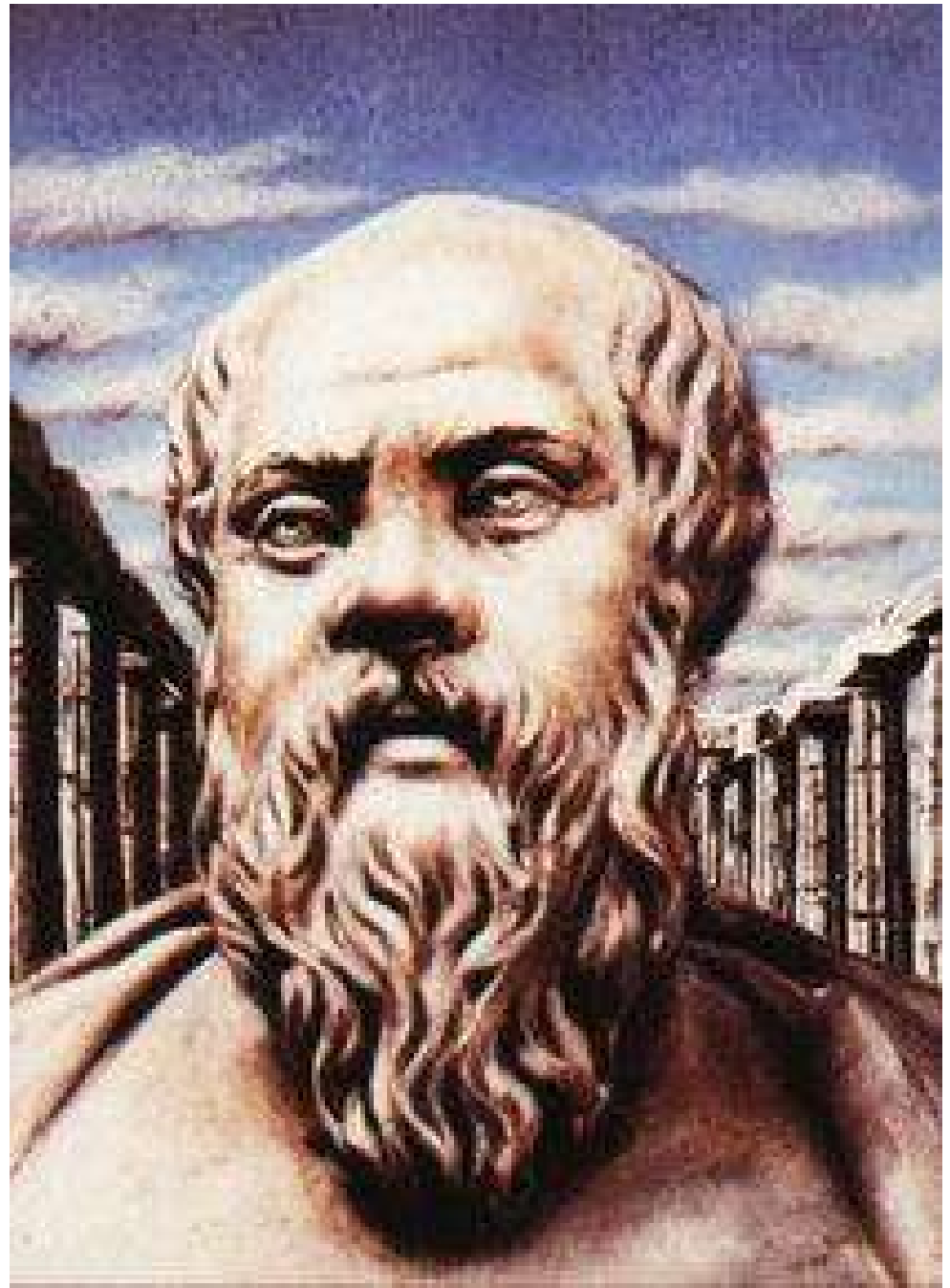

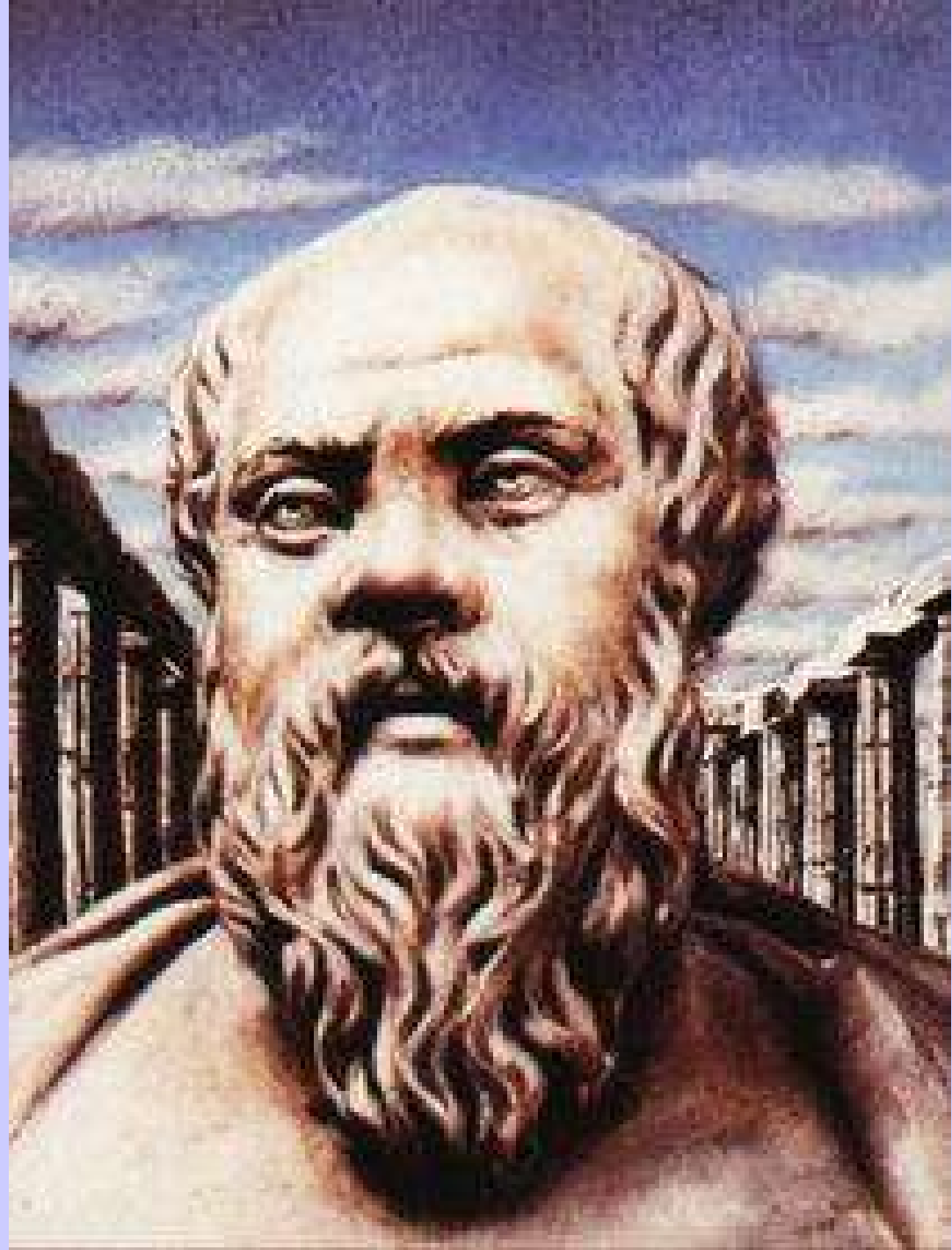
Socrates, Plato, and Aristotle



Socrates

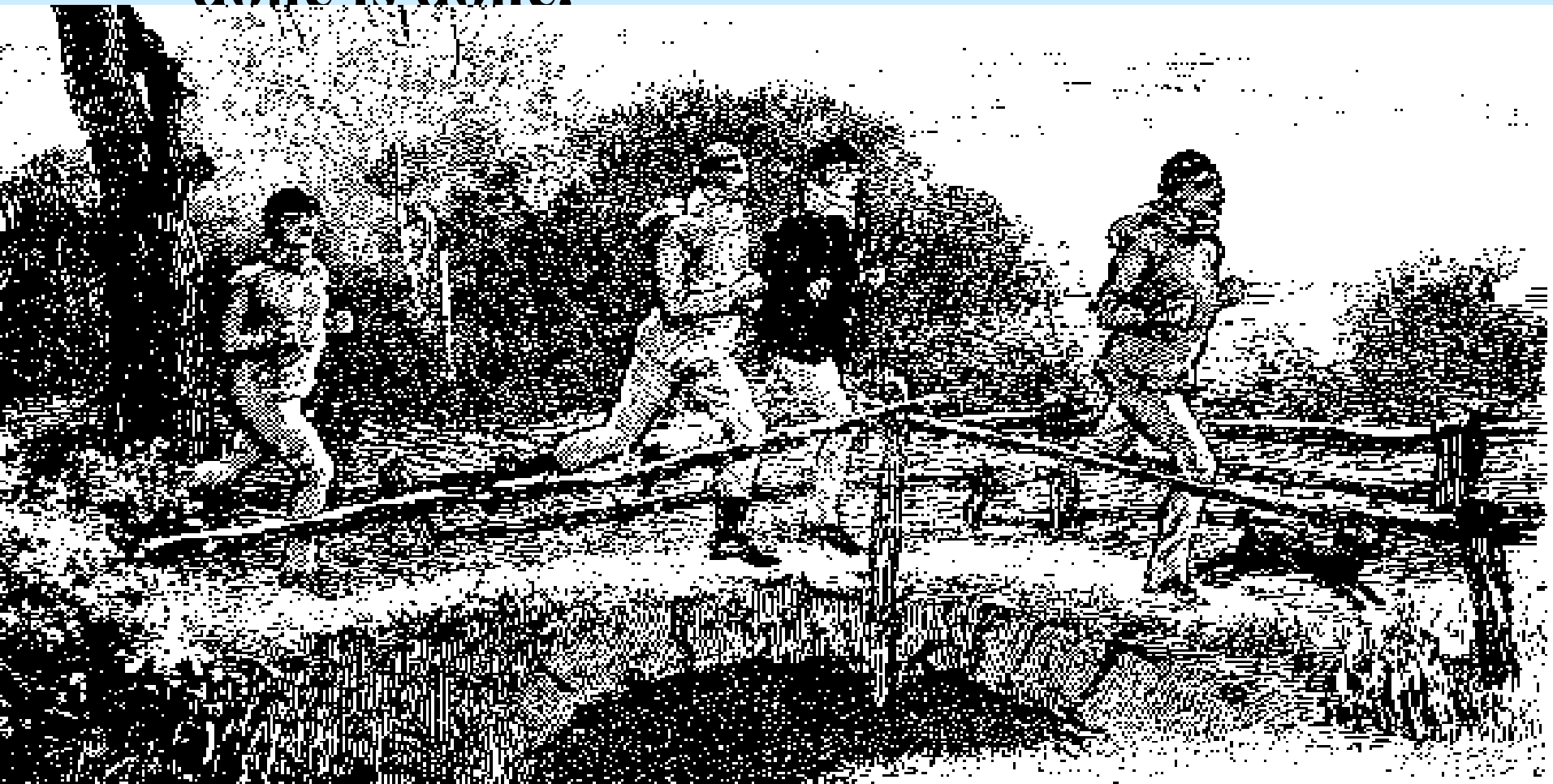


Socrates was convicted at the age of 70 of corrupting the youth for teaching the youth to challenge authority.



His friends encouraged him to flee...

- “I will not go against the law. What’s done is done.”



Socrates drank a poison in his cell, rather than facing an execution.

Aristotle

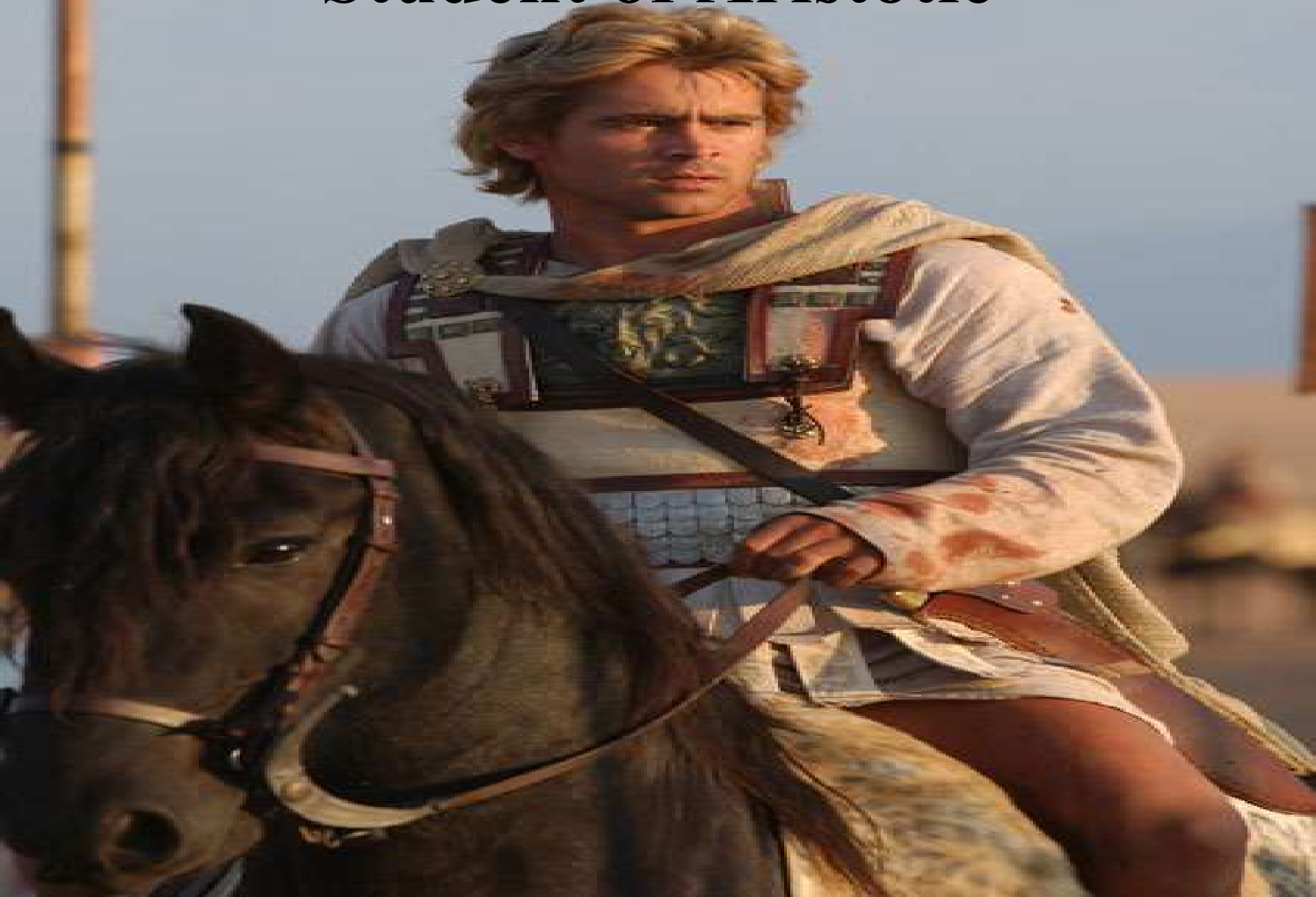


Aristotle

- **Politics, ethics, logic, biology, literature, physics**

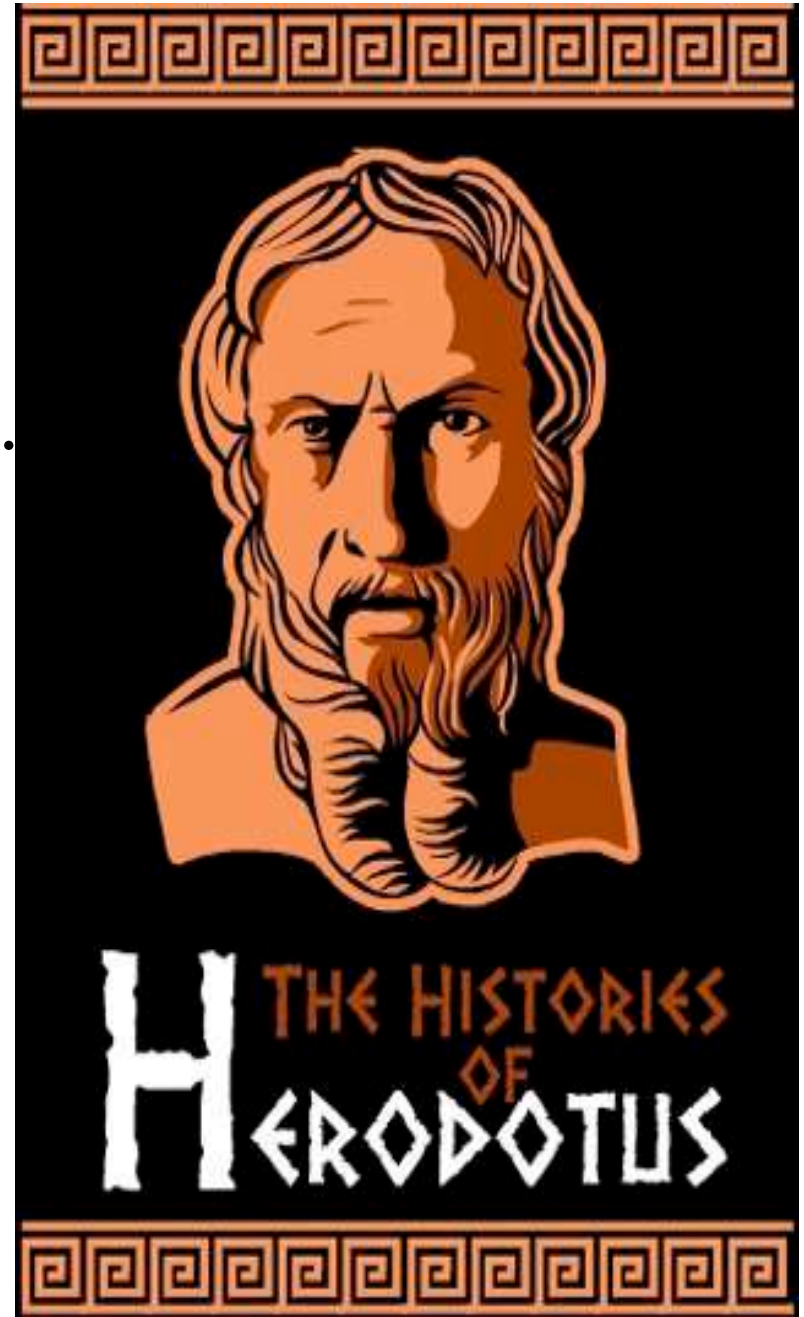


Student of Aristotle



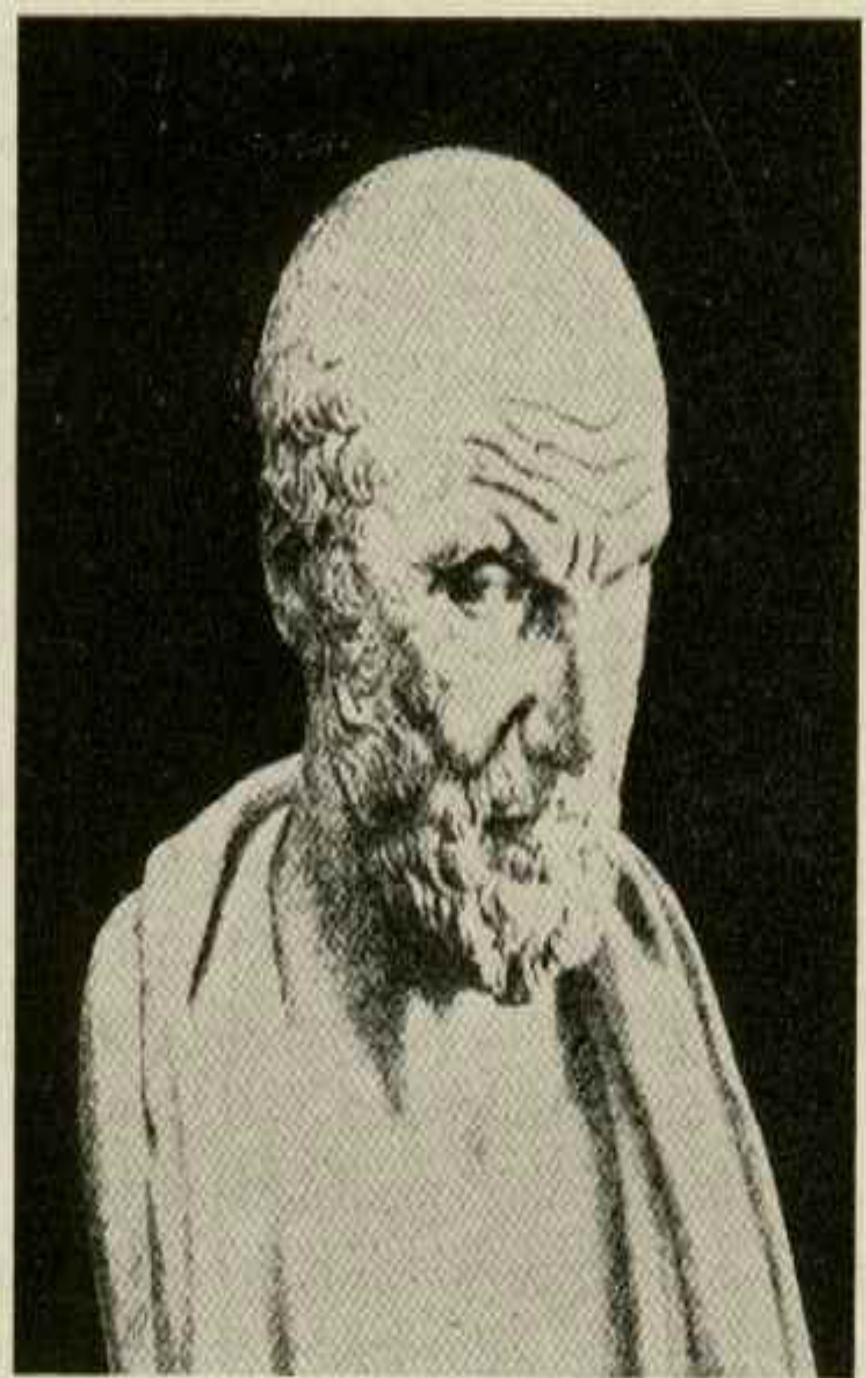
Herodotus
