




Consequences

Language Arts

e will use the Benchmark Advance reading program Reading, writing, phonics, and grammar program Skills are taught through read alouds and shared readings Narrative and informational texts Guided reading groups will provide for small group, focused instruction

Language Arts

First graders are expected to master their sight words.

These are words that are read quickly by sight

When your child is ready to be tested, please sign the list and return it school in the Homework Folder

I will send home a "passed" or "re-try" test home the following week

At the end of each month, I will test tall students on the corresponding sight word list

Math

We will use the Envision Common Core Math program. Units of study include addition and subtraction to 20, problem solving, place value, relationship between addition and subtraction, reading, writing and recognizing numbers to 120, time and measurement.

Science

In Science, first graders will be learning about plants, animals, habitats, space, light, and sound.

This will correspond with the Language Arts unit we are studying at the time

Social Studies

First graders will be learning about rules, laws, community helpers, maps, symbols, long ago/today, goods, and services.

This will correspond with the Language Arts unit we are studying at the time

Chromebooks will be used each day in class (starting the second week of school)
Students will learn computer skills in class and utilize online programs
