# Griswold Elementary School

Your child will be entering kindergarten this fall. The following requirements must be completed by your child's practitioner and brought to Griswold Elementary School as soon as completed. These are State of Connecticut requirements and **must** be met before your child **may enter** kindergarten.

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| Physical exam with Hemoglobin/<br>Hematocrit | ● Dated within one year of the start of school   |
| 4-5 doses DTP                                | ● Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis - last dose must be given on or after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday                                      |
| 3 - 4 doses POLIO                            | ● Polio Vaccine - last dose must be given on or after 4th birthday   |
| 2 MMR's                                      | ● Measles, Mumps, Rubella - 1 <sup>st</sup> dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday  |
| Hep B Series                                 | ● 3 in a series - last dose on or after 24 weeks of age  |
| Hep A  | ● 2 doses given 6 mo. apart - 1 <sup>st</sup> dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday  |
| 1 dose HIB                                   | ● Heamophilus Influenzae - one dose on or after 1st birthday for children less than 5 years old                                      |
| Varicella                                    | ● 2 doses of varicella vaccine – 1 <sup>st</sup> given on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday or doctor's documentation of the disease |
| Pneumococcal                                 | ● 1 dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday for children less than 5 years old   |
| Recommended                                  | ● 1 Tuberculosis screening with result<br>1 Lead screening with results  |

Please call your doctors **early** to schedule appointments and have your doctor fill out the enclosed **blue** Connecticut State physical form and return it to Griswold Elementary School, Att: School Nurse, 303 Slater Avenue, Griswold, CT 06351. Return this form to the school office as soon as the physical exam is completed. The GES office is open during the summer.

**Remember your child cannot start school unless their health records are up to date and the records are in school.**
