Parents may use this system to PREPAY for their child's meals.
THIS IS A DEBIT, NOT A CREDIT, SYSTEM.

The Food & Nutrition Services is a self-supporting operation within the school district and is not set up to send home bills for money owed. Students must have money in their account to receive a meal.

NOW AVAILABLE - "My School Account" - Online Payment Option.

This service allows parents to make deposits and view your children's account balances and purchases. For instructions please go to the district website www.tolland.k12.ct.us go to district offices, then food services.

How do I put money on my child's account? You can use the online service described above or you can send a payment to school with your child. Your child can then give the form & check to their teacher or hand it to the cashier during lunch service. We recommend that advanced payments be sent in the form of a check. Please write the student's name on the check. You may use the form at the bottom of this page, or have your student pick one up throughout the school year at the cashier station. Cashiers will hand a form to your child when their balance is running low.

What do the options mean? To purchase milk and/or meals on account and snacks (where available), please select "Meals and A La Carte". "Meals Only" means exactly that, the money you send in may ONLY be used to purchase a full meal.

Lunch Credit Procedure: Our lunch credit procedure for students at TMS who do not have cash or money in their account is to allow the purchase of <u>ONE</u> lunch on credit. When the one-lunch credit has been reached the student will receive a granola bar so they will not go hungry. The granola bar is provided by the school PTO, not the food service department.

How do I know when my child's account is running low on money? You can use the on-line system to check balances or contact the cafeteria manager or the food service office at the numbers below to get your child's lunch account balance. Cashiers will do their best to inform your child and hand him/her a form when his/her balance is running low
