

Pre-K Expectations

- Toilet Training
 - Please send in a change of clothes 'just in case'!
 - Excessive accidents (more than 5) could result in dismissal from the program.
- Absences
 - Excuses need to be turned in within 3 days. Students have a total of 10 excused absences.
 - More than 10 unexcused absences could result in being removed from the program.
- We believe in bell-to-bell teaching. Every minute of every day is important in our classrooms! Our school day begins at 7:30 and ends at 2:10.



Transportation

All transportation must be submitted in writing/email prior to 10:00 am.

Car tags are required for all students being picked up in the car rider line.

Parents with both primary and elementary students should drop off and pick up on the elementary side of the building.
