Subject/Activity	Time Spent
Language Arts	60-75 minutes
Snack/Brain Break	20 minutes
Math	45-60 minutes
Lunch/Free Play	40 minutes
Social Studies	30-45 minutes
Science	30-45 minutes
Brain Break	10 minutes
Art, PE, etc.	30 minutes

If you do at least the minimum, it adds up to over 240 minutes of learning per day!



- For Math and Language Arts Edgenuity has a lesson every weekday. The 5 lessons for the week are called a module. They have 18 modules which makes for 1 module per week.
- For Science and Social Studies –
 Edgenuity has 1 module every 3 weeks,
 for a total of 6 modules. Which means
 doing 1 to 2 every week will keep you on
 track.
- Assessments for both are every 6 lessons.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES


- Daily attendance is REQUIRED for virtual classrooms. Just like it was for normal classes, attendance will be taken EVERY DAY.




- We will also be using Google Classroom for things like messaging.

GRADING

- While Edgenuity does display grades for students in the dashboard, this may not be their final grade.

- In Edgenuity, the "Actual Grade" factors in unsubmitted assignments as zeroes, whereas the "Overall Grade" only factors what they have submitted.
