Wilson Project 2000 College Scholarship Program Application Packet

The goal of Project 2000 is to promote greater student success in all curriculum areas by making the school and the parents more productive partners in the education of their children. Project 2000 is a cooperative agreement with Arizona State University (ASU), Northern Arizona University (NAU), and the Maricopa Community Colleges to provide scholarships to those top performing high school students who may not qualify for other college scholarships or financial aid.



Project 2000 College Scholarship Program

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must have attended Wilson Primary School and/or Wilson Elementary School
- 2. Must be a <u>legal</u> resident as required by state law (Dreamers do not qualify)
- 3. Must be a high school senior with a cumulative academic G.P.A. of 3.0 for university or 2.5 for community college
- 4. Must be planning to attend ASU, NAU or any Maricopa Community College (enrollment will be verified)

Application Requirements

The following must be completed before your application is considered:

- 1. Complete the Application
 - Fill out the application completely and submit it to Wilson Elementary no later than January 31, 2023
- 2. Include a Personal Statement with your application
- Must be a **one page**, <u>typed</u> document that addresses the questions asked
- 3. Obtain 3 Letters of Recommendation
 - Distribute the link to 3 teachers- please see the required course. Applications will not be reviewed until recommendations are received, must be received by 1/31/23
- 4. Submit Transcripts
 - Current unofficial transcripts from all high schools attended
- 5. Record of completed FAFSA form (<u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u>), a printout confirmation is acceptable
- 6. Include a copy of your college/university acceptance letter
- 7. A copy of your high school diploma, final official high school transcript, college registration forms and/or college schedule of classes must be received by *June 30, 2023*. You are encouraged to apply to more than one university or college.

Applications must be received by <u>January 31, 2023</u> Applications are not considered complete until all components are completed and received by Wilson Elementary (Gaby Duran) Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Determination of Eligibility

All students who apply for the Project 2000 Scholarship Program will be evaluated for eligibility based on their:

- 1. Academic Achievement
- 2. Letters of Recommendation
- 3. Personal Statement

If the Project 2000 Scholarship is awarded

All students who are selected to receive the award must do the following:

 Bring a High School Diploma & Official High School Transcripts, College Registration Form and/or College Schedule of Classes to Wilson Community Center Office by <u>June 30, 2023.</u> (Students at ASU or NAU must be registered as full time students. Students at Community Colleges must be registered for at least 9 credits.)

Continuation of Project 2000

Scholarship awards will be renewed to students who meet the following criteria <u>each semester</u>:

- 1. Enroll as a full-time student attending ASU & NAU. Or at least 9 credits at a Maricopa Community College.
- 2. Maintain a minimum cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher for ASU & NAU & 2.5 for Community College.
- 3. Submit semester grades and a new semester schedule to Ms. Gaby Duran, Wilson Community Center.
- 4. Update home and cell phone numbers, mailing address, email address and emergency contact information.
- 5. Attend at least one Wilson Elementary activity or event (such as a classroom presentation, career/college fair, or community service) each semester.

For those students who are awarded the Project 2000 Scholarship and maintain the above conditions, the scholarship award will continue for each successive year of college attendance (two years for community colleges and four years for universities). *The scholarship will not continue for those students who take a semester or year off.*
