 - 1. Science-standards were recently approved. (NGSS) incorporates more engineering. There will be more curriculum changes in science based on these new standards.
 - 2. Language Arts-Letter sent home to parents stating which novels they will be working on. 6th grade letter did not state any specific books....just the type of unit they would be working on.

- J. Facilities-Fishbowl room in library will be used for Capstone project classroom. Office Depot will be donating money to be used for Makerspace. K. Technology

System-wide PTAC update-Updated bus camera project. Presently testing routes that would need cameras. Two bus routes have been found to need the cameras so far.

School Photographer project-Would like school level PTACS to decide what they would like included in the photo contract. They need a decision by April so town can choose a vendor.

Moran wants no fee for retakes and lowest cost to parents. SM will share this with system wide PTAC.

Healthy food certification-close but need to get a little closer to get an extra 5 cents per meal.
