## **Happening in October**

1. Box Tops -

Melissa – last year we made \$1036, this year our goal will be \$1200.

- Our first submission is 11/1.
- A letter will be going home in regards to box tops and explained. A paper will be attached where you can staple each box top.
- Melissa has a list of products that participate.
- On the box top website parents can add their name and school and they will send you emails. The website also provides coupons for products that participate with box tops. They have a contest every month. The last contest gave a school 10,000 box tops, which equals \$1000.
