The check will be approximately in the amount \$18,000 or more depending on if additional funds are deposited from other upcoming fundraisers. The balance in the Main account is \$35,884.00. The checks from Scholastic, Great American Opportunities and MCA have not yet cleared. When they do it will bring our balance in our main account to approximately \$22,400.

Upcoming big expenses include the field day T-shirts and the money that is allotted yearly to each classroom teacher that runs at an approximate expense of \$4,000.00
