Grading System

Tests/quizzes = 70% Homework = 30%

100%-90% = A, 89%-80% = B, 79%-70% = C, 69%-60% = D, 59% and below = F

***Work habit grade** (O, S, N, U) will be affected by **missing assignments**

***Citizenship grade** (O, S, N, U) will be **determined** by behavior in class

Tests/Quizzes

1. **Tests** and/or **Quizzes** will be given each chapter.
2. In the event the student is absent on a test or quiz day, it is the **student's responsibility** to make up the missed test or quiz within a week of the absence or receive a zero.
Make-ups are given after school ONLY.

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Homework

1. Homework is assigned **daily**. **All homework assignments are posted online!** **No late work is accepted**, unless a student is absent. If a student is absent they have one day for every day they were absent to make up their work.
2. Students are **expected** to keep all assignments and math notes in a binder/notebook.
3. Homework is considered **complete** when:
 - a. It is done in **pencil**. (NO PEN ALLOWED ON ASSIGNMENTS)
 - b. Homework paper is labeled **properly**.
 - c. **Class review is finished** and the work is shown.
 - d. All homework problems are finished and the **work is shown**.
4. Students are **encouraged** to ask questions about problems they get incorrect or do not understand.
5. I am **available for math help**. Days and times to be determined due to our new start times. Students will also have access to **IXL (a fantastic math site with unlimited practice questions covering all of the 7th grade standards)**.
