MED Honors Chemistry Course Syllabus 2018-19

Grades will be determined by the following **five components**:

1. Notebook, Projects, & Lessons

- Assignments should be neat and organized in your Interactive Science Notebook; this includes classwork, homework, labs, notes, and other class materials.
- Notebooks will be graded periodically.
- Projects will be ongoing throughout each term.
- Lessons will be posted on the Google Classroom website and should be completed in a timely manner, working ahead is good but falling behind is bad. In addition, when turning in assignments, you must attach a screenshot/picture of completed work (including time stamp).
- worth **20**% of overall grade

2. Lab Safety & Participation

- Pre-lab *must be prepped before* the class period in which it will be completed. Incomplete Pre-labs will require the student to: (1) complete the pre-lab in class & make up the lab at a later time, (2) complete a 2-3 page (double-spaced, size 12, Times New Roman font) report about the lab topic to be due within 1 week, *OR* (3) complete an alternative assignment
- All safety practices and procedures followed during the lab.
- Each lab member is on task during the lab.
- Failure to honor safety rules may result in the dismissal from all future labs.
- worth **5**% of overall grade (approximately 10 total labs)

3. Lab Reports

- A full lab report is due *the day after* the completion of the lab
- Lab report must be submitted via Google Docs/Drive through the respective Google Classroom assignment.
- If a student has an excused absence the day of the lab, they have no more than 1 week to make it up.
- worth **20**% of overall grade

4. Assessments

- Concept quizzes will be administered on a regular basis.
- Mastery of a concept will be demonstrated on quizzes; once the concept has been mastered twice (a score of 4 on 2 separate quizzes) the student is no longer required to complete questions related to that concept on any quiz
- each concept is worth 5 points when fully mastered
- Quizzes may be taken as many times as needed to earn full credit (same concepts, but different questions) within a two week period
- Failing a quiz automatically calls for the student to attend tutorial, complete a quiz analysis assignment, and then retake the quiz.
- Grade intervention reports will be ran after every quiz to determine if home notification is necessary regarding course progress
- Worth 45% of overall grade

5. Final Exam

- final exam will be given at the end of each term and is cumulative
- worth 10% of overall grade

Classroom Rules

- 1. Be on-time, on-task, and prepared to learn EVERYDAY.
- 2. Keep all personal electronics PUT AWAY. They will be taken and turned in to the office if they are out in class **without permission** (this is your warning).
- 3. BE RESPONSIBLE for your own learning. **Keep all graded work**.
- 4. RESPECT the teacher, the classroom, other students, and yourself.
- 5. CLEAN UP after yourself and your peers.
- 6. Follow ALL lab and safety directions.

 the student miss 3 or more consecutive days, the student needs to see the teacher to work
 out a schedule.
