Seal of Multiliteracy

What it is?

• The Riverside County Seal of Multiliteracy is an award given by the Riverside County Office of Education to students who have attained high levels of proficiency in English and at least one other world language by the time of their high school graduation.

What are the benefits?

- Assurance of a marketable skill
- ◆Transcript notation
- Recognition of the award at graduation (Students will be allowed to wear their Seal)
- Conferral of award at county-wide recognition dinner ceremony
- ◆ Special seal on your diploma
- Digital badge (assigned by the county office)
- Recognition is done early enough to include on your college applications

Who is eligible to apply?

- ✓ Students who will be a senior in the fall Demonstrate proficiency in English on the *School Verification* form, accomplish <u>all</u> of the following:
- ✓ On track to complete all ELA requirements for graduation.
- ✓ Overall GPA of 2.0 or above to date in ELA classes required for graduation.
- ✓ Pass the CAASPP/ELA (administered in grade eleven) at or above the "standard met" achievement level.
- ✓ Attain the level demonstrating English language proficiency on the ELPAC in transitional kindergarten or kindergarten through grade twelve, inclusive. (Only if your primary language is other than English)

California Seal of Biliteracy Reciprocity



If student has already demonstrated proficiency in one or more languages other than English, they automatically qualify to be recognized and receive both the Riverside County Seal of Multiliteracy and the California Seal of Biliteracy. However, you will need to complete the Parent Authorization and the Student Application forms.

California Seal of Biliteracy Reciprocity



The following are ways to demonstrate proficiency:

- *Pass a foreign language AP exam, including American Sign Language, with a score of "3" or higher.
- *Pass an foreign language IB exam with a score of "4" or higher.
 - *Pass the SAT II foreign language exam with a score of "600" or higher.

How and when can I apply?

- Interested students must submit an <u>Student</u>
 <u>Application & Parent Authorization</u> between
 Monday, May 1, 2020 and Monday, August 31,
 2020 no later than 12:30 via email.
- DO NOT DO THIS ON YOUR PHONE THE COUNTY WILL NOT BE ABLE TO READ THE FORMS!
- Complete the form on the link in the email that Mrs. King sent you.

Step 1: Complete the *Parent Authorization* form and upload it on your computer.


The Parent Authorization form is in the email Mrs.

What to name your Parent Authorization form:

LastName_FirstName_School_Parent

- Example:
- Smith_Mary_GreatOakHighSchool_Parent

• (This is how the RCOE will ask you to name your Parent Authorization form.) (You put "parent" at the end because this form is the *Parent Authorization*.)


Step 2: Complete the *Student Application* on-line and upload your signed *Parent Authorization* form.


Information needed for the *Student Application* form:

- Page 1: Email address, Date,
- Page 2: Name, Birthday, Mailing Address, Phone numbers
- Page 3: Will you be a senior this school year?,
 District, School, Site Rep., Site Rep. email
- Our site representative is: KARLA WETTELAND
- Her email is: kwetteland@tvusd.us
- Page 4: Language(s) and dialect (if applicable),

Information needed Continued:

- Page 5: Explanation about eligibility criteria
- Page 6: Check if you have completed English in 9th, 10th, 11th grades and are currently enrolled, overall unweighted E.L.A. G.P.A.
- Page 7: Language exam taken (A.P., I.B. or S.A.T. II),
 Language of exam, Exam score, Electronic signature
- Page 8: Upload file and verify that you have uploaded it
- Page 9: Submit form
