## Redo/Retake Policy 8<sup>th</sup> Grade World History

## Teacher Required Redos (below a 70% on a summative assessment)-

- -4 evidences of studying must be turned in on the assigned redo day
- 1. Test reflection is required to be turned in as a piece of evidence of study
- 2. Workbook sheets that pertain to the content must be filled in and turned in (ADV skip this step)
- 3. 2 other forms of studying must also be turned in (notecards, printed out practice test from the online textbook, foldables, gsprite chart, other teacher-approved method)
- -if all 4 pieces of evidence are not turned in on your assigned redo day, the student must write a letter of apology to both the parents and teacher for being unprepared & possibly irresponsible.
- -The retest will still be taken to assess mastery of the content. The student will receive the highest of the two test grades. The redo process is set up to assist the student and if there's a failure to relearn the material by the second deadline the student will still be held responsible for mastery by the 9 weeks test and/or semester exam.

<u>Student Requested Retest</u> – this is for any student who would like the opportunity to retake a test that originally made 70% or higher. The student must follow the guidelines listed below:

- \*understand that these are permitted at teacher discretion
- \*the teacher reserves the right to give an *alternative version* of the assessment to ensure mastery and not just memorization
- \*in order to obtain permission and schedule a retest, the student must submit a plan for relearning along with an email requesting to retest within 24 hours of receiving a test back.
- \*Evidence of studying will be turned in on retest day (see numbers 1, 2, and 3 above)
- \* If the evidence of studying is not turned in, the student will not be able to retest and the option will not be given to retest on that material. The student will need to turn in a letter apologizing for breaking the trust of the teacher and parents.
- \*Students who choose to retest will receive the second grade.
- \*The teacher selects the retest date & time.
