

We're excited to start registering students for the upcoming school year! After studying state and local health guidelines, and listening to the needs and concerns of our families, staff, and community, we're happy to offer two learning experiences this fall:

Montezuma County will open all PreK-12 schools on August 17. All may choose to attend school in person, five days a week, Monday - Friday. We'll adhere to rigorous safety measures throughout the day and after class hours. Occasional home learning will occur when needed.



Families also have the choice of fully remote/online learning. This option remains remote throughout the year, and will meet all state learning requirements.

As you know, so much is **still in flux** as we plan with you for the upcoming months. In order for us to prepare as best we can, please register all students by **August 7**. Below are the simple steps you will take to register both remote and in-school learners. You can register either in person or online for new and returning students. If your student went to school here last year and was promoted to their next school, consider them a returning student.

While registering online is easy, we will also have **in person registration days**, with all necessary safety protocols. MCHS registration will start at 8am on July 30, and K-8 students will register on August 6 at their individual schools, starting at 8am. You will get help setting up your Parent Portal account on these days.

For online registration, starting July 27:
