- 2. How were Renaissance artists trained? What was their status in Renaissance society? Who was their audience?
- 3. What new artistic techniques were introduced by Renaissance artists?
- 4. In what ways did Renaissance art and philosophy reinforce each other?
- 5. How was the Renaissance artist different in personal style from his medieval predecessors?
- 6. How did Renaissance art reflect the political and social events of the period?
- 7. How did the artists of the Renaissance incorporate the new intellectual and cultural trends of their time into their art?

What You Need To Do:

- 1. Research your artist using the databases
- 2. Make your note cards
- 3. Write your research question
- 4. Write your interview be sure to focus on your research question (minimum of 2 pages)
- 5. On the last page of the interview (page 3) Include an image of the artist's artwork.
- 6. Bibliography (page 4)
