

# Renaissance Magazine Article

Your editor does not want a simple biographical sketch, but rather, has asked you to delve deeper into their motivations, training and philosophy. Your editor has provided you with the following sample research questions to get you started. You are free to use a couple of these if you wish. However, your editor is requiring that you come up with one original research question as part of your story.

1. How was Renaissance art different from medieval art and Gothic architecture?
2. How were Renaissance artists trained? What was their status in Renaissance society? Who was their audience?
3. What new artistic techniques were introduced by Renaissance artists?
4. In what ways did Renaissance art and philosophy reinforce each other?
5. How was the Renaissance artist different in personal style from his medieval predecessors?
6. How did Renaissance art reflect the political and social events of the period?
7. How did the artists of the Renaissance incorporate the new intellectual and cultural trends of their time into their art?

## What You Need To Do:

1. Research your artist using the databases
2. Make your note cards
3. Write your research question
4. Write your interview - be sure to focus on your research question (minimum of 2 pages)
5. On the last page of the interview (page 3) Include an image of the artist's artwork.
6. Bibliography (page 4)
