

Requirements for earning the Seal of Fine and Performing Arts from Columbus City Schools:

Students must demonstrate skill(s) in the fine or performing arts over the course of their high school career. Fine and performing arts can be described as visual art, dance, theatre, and music. Ideas of fine and performing arts opportunities include, but are not limited to:

- Art Exhibition
- School or Community Theatre Participation
- School, District, or Community Musical Performance (group, ensemble, and/or solo)
- School, District or Community Dance Performance (group, ensemble, and/or solo)
- District or Community Music Festivals
- Theatrical Design and Production (e.g., set and costumes, lighting and sound)
- Composition (e.g., music and dance) and Digital Recording Projects
- Playwriting
- Media and Broadcast Production
- Fine Art Portfolios

Teachers and the Principal or designee will input information pertaining to the fine and performing arts into the student information system. Both the teachers and Principal or designee will monitor. All documentation must be entered into the student information system no later than three weeks prior to the student's graduation date.
