#### **GUIDELINES**

- All information in the brochure should be summarized in your own words.
- You will be graded daily for your use of class time in the library.
- All images should have the URL below the image. If you only used an image from the source, you are not required to include the source on the works cited page.
- Sources used for research information should be integrated into your works cited page.
- You should consult the Simsbury High School's databases for your research. You may consult these databases from home. Additional allowable Internet sources, not in the databases, will be provided in class. Wikipedia is NOT allowed. You may also consult any books that you may find useful (library books, magazines, encyclopedias, textbook, etc.).
- If you do not have MS Publisher at home, you may access from home the software in the school computer labs and the library. You may also access the software at the Simsbury Public Library.
- If you do not have MS Publisher at home, you may still complete research at home accessing the school databases from home and use a MS Word document to record your information for the brochure. You then can either email your work to yourself or use a flash drive to store the work. In class, you will then be able to copy the information from MS Word to your brochure in MS Publisher.
