Dear Center School Families,

As summer continues to treat us to warm, sunshine-filled days, we are beginning to anticipate the opening of school for the 2016-2017 school year. On August 31<sup>st</sup> the buses will roll and we will officially begin our year. The official school hours for this school year are 8:40-3:25 p.m. We hope that you will access the transportation brochure as a resource for you to keep handy throughout the school year. You can view this brochure on the C.E.S. website under the "About US" link on the top of the home page. Just click on "bus information" to find the brochure.

Please give your child an opportunity to ride the bus from the first day of school. Capture this momentous occasion with photos at the bus stop. The circular driveway in front of the school will be reserved for buses. If it is absolutely necessary for you to drive your child to school, please follow the signs for drop-off around the back of the building. Again, please read the transportation brochure for further details. For the first few days of school, teachers will be in the gym to meet the children as they come off the bus.

- 1 Box Crayola Colored Pencils
- 4 Large Pink Erasers
- Crayola Classic Color Markers (10 ct)
- 4 Assorted Colors Plastic Pocket Folders  
(MUST BE Red, Blue, Green & Yellow)
- 2 Boxes of Tissues
- 2 Packs of Baby Wipes
- 2 Pads of 3x3 Yellow Sticky Notes
- 1 Hardcover Black & White Composition Notebook
- Expo Dry Erase Markers (4 pack) **BLACK only**
- 1 Pack of 3x5 White Lined Index Cards (Iamartino and Sullivan only)

**Do not label supplies with your child's name.**  
Check school website for teacher specific additional supplies.

Children will eat lunch in school on the first day. Lunch menus are available on the website at [brookfieldps.org](http://brookfieldps.org) and will be sent home on a monthly basis.

Anyone interested in volunteering at Center School during the 2016-2017 school year, must complete the Brookfield Public School Volunteer Form(s). The school website will provide all needed information and forms. Approvals may take up to two weeks to process.
