#### HOW WILL STUDENTS KNOW WHAT TO DO?

- Starting Monday, April 13, 2020, every teacher will post assignments that will cover the next 6 weeks. There will be no grades given to these assignments.
- Students with internet will need to login to their Google account to make sure they have access to all of their Google Classrooms for all core (English, Math, Science, Social Science) classes.
- Teachers will spend this week adding students to their Google Classrooms.

#### HOW WILL I GET FEEDBACK ON MY WORK?

- Teachers will be available daily through email and Google Classroom.
  - Teachers will be available form 8:00 AM-3:00 PM Monday - Friday.
- Teachers may have a weekly ZOOM call with students that have access.

### HOW CAN I TALK TO A REAL PERSON?

- Parents may request meetings with the administration via email or phone calls.
- All conferences will be done either video conferencing or phone calls.
- We are not allowed to have a conference at school.

#### WHAT IF I DO NOT HAVE INTERNET AT HOME?

- We will have a pickup day Monday, April 13, 2020, from 10:00 AM-7:00 PM for all RCS schools.
- You will come to the front circles of all schools.
- You will remain in the car and an RMS staff member will bring you the packet.
- Packets will not be turned in for a grade.
- Printed packets will contain the same information as the online packets.

#### WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS AN IEP OR A 504 PLAN?

- Students with these plans will be supported!
- Your case manager will be in constant contact with teachers and you.
- Meetings can still take place using Google Meet/Hangout.
