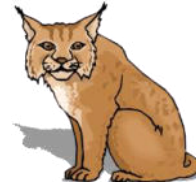

## Focus on Health and Safety:

### Student Daily COVID Tracker

Families, please be sure to make your Student Tracker a part of your daily morning routine. The tracker, found on ParentVue, needs to be completed by **9:30AM** every school day.

When the Student Tracker is not filled in by you, our Health Assistants need to pull your child from class to screen him/her. This not only interrupts your child's learning, but it also takes our Health Assistants away from helping our kids who may need them here in the building and help to keep our building clean and sanitized.

### Before School Safety



To reduce cross grade-level interaction, all learners should report directly to their classroom when arriving on campus. Classroom doors will open at 8:35 am to bus riders and breakfast will begin at 8:35 am; however, **we are asking students arrive as**

**close to our first bell at 8:50 am as possible.** If your child arrives after our tardy bell, 8:55 am, he/she



will need to report to the office to check in and receive a tardy slip.

This procedure has been working well; however, please remind your child(ren) to report directly to his/her classroom when arriving on campus. We do not have adult supervision before school other than Mrs. Moreno and Mrs. Kallus greeting students in the front and in each classroom.

Breakfast is still available starting at 8:35am. Students should come in the front of the building to get to the cafeteria

### Safety and Flow of Traffic in Our Parking Lot

With half as many families, we are doing a great job during drop off and pick up. Please remember to use a parking spot when leaving your vehicle – please do not leave your car unattended on the curb. Also, if using the dirt road to the East of our campus, please do not park facing north; proceed to the end and turn around and park facing south. Finally, please do not park on the East side of Fremont street – they will ticket your vehicle. Thanks for helping to keep our learners safe!

### Dismissal –Please Review with your Child(ren)

With our recent staff discussions and Phase 1 expectations outlined by the district, we have decided to stagger our dismissal. Any learners who walk or ride their bikes, will be dismissed at 3:55 pm to meet any other family members and start their journey home. All other learners will be dismissed at 4:00 pm to meet their ride, report to extended hours or catch the bus.
