Sea anemones:

 Will attack a non-relative

 Does not attack relatives

Rocky Shore: Invertebrates

Mussels

- Related to clams and oysters
- Found in clumps attached to rocks
- Can become exposed at low tide
- Make an adhesive 10 times stickier than super glue





Rocky Shore: Invertebrates

Sea Stars

- No such thing as starfish
 They are not fish. They are echinoderms
- Found near musselsMussels are their main prey
- Tube feet create a powerful suction
 - Tear open mussels and clamsSpit their stomach out of their mouths
 - Digest prey and slurp it back in

Kelp Forests


Kelp Structure

- Not like an ordinary plant
- Has holdfasts instead of roots
- Pneumatocysts keep it afloat
 [®]Air bladders
- They form a canopy, like a forest
- Not really a plant
 - **10**It is actually algae
- Each organism can be 90 feet high

 Øplant' part of it is called a frond

Kelp Forests ••• Kelp forests have seasons Spring and summer ¹⁰Fronts can grow 3 feet per day – Autumn Water is clear and warm ¹⁰Animals are most abundant – Winter ¹⁰Fronds are 'shed' like leaves ¹⁰Sea otters often wrap themselves in kelp for warmth
