Course Selections: Things to Consider

- Choose classes carefully- changes may not be possible later!
- We try to honor student course selections, however, sometimes courses do not “make up”
- Check Program of Studies for course descriptions and pre-requisites
- Make choices based on individual strengths and interests, not based on what your friends are taking or what you’ve “heard” about a course and/or teacher
- Consider other activities that also require time (sports, clubs, work, theater, band, etc.)
- Challenge yourself!... **WITHIN REASON!**
 - A “challenge” may be different for each individual student
 - Intensified and AP courses expect 45 min. to 1.5 hours of homework every day
