

INFORMATION ON YOUR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER

Your school has a School-Based Health Center (SBHC), operated by the school's community partner, Child & Family Agency of Southeastern Connecticut (CFA)!

CFA has been operating SBHCs for more than 30 years and operates 13 School-Based Health Centers in this region with a Nurse Practitioner (APRN) and Mental Health Clinician (therapist) at each location.



The School-Based Health Center is different from the school nurse's office and a community primary care doctor but works collaboratively with them to provide comprehensive care for students.



Health insurance is billed for services provided, but there is no cost to the family (no co-pays, deductible costs, or out-of-pocket expenses).



Same-day medical appointments are available to registered students! Please note that we request that registrations are updated annually.
