Recipients must attain a minimum 2.75 grade point average during the fall/winter sessions of the academic year and maintain full-time enrollment in the schools of engineering and/or chemistry to receive funding for the spring session.

Student Eligibility Requirements

The Foundation wishes to encourage qualified students with the talent and commitment to succeed to pursue careers in engineering and/or chemistry and has established the following criteria for evaluation:

Must be a high school senior or undergraduate college student and a citizen of the United States at the time of application.

Must have at least a 3.5 grade point average (based on a 4.0 scale) for the 10th and 11th grades or at least a 3.0 accumulated college grade point average for undergraduate college students.

Must intend to earn a degree in engineering and/or chemistry and plan to enter the practice of engineering and/or chemistry after graduation.

Must be enrolled at the University of Denver or Colorado School of Mines prior to the awarding of the scholarship.

High school seniors must have attained minimum test scores on either of the following standardized tests, Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Testing Program (ACT). Test results may not be mixed to obtain minimum thresholds.

Evaluation Standards
