Mark T. Sheehan High School is a 4-year comprehensive public high school, grades 9-12, with an enrollment of approximately 800 students. MTS provides a challenging and supportive environment that inspires students to be critical thinkers, effective communicators, and responsible, contributing members of a dynamic global society. The school operates on an alternate day block schedule, and is accredited through the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. Current senior class size is 191 students.

Class Rank

Class rank is calculated on a 4.0 weighted scale and based on the quality point average earned. All seniors with a cumulative GPA of 3.9 or higher are recognized as a Varsity Scholar. **All students who transfer in after their freshman year will be co-ranked.**
